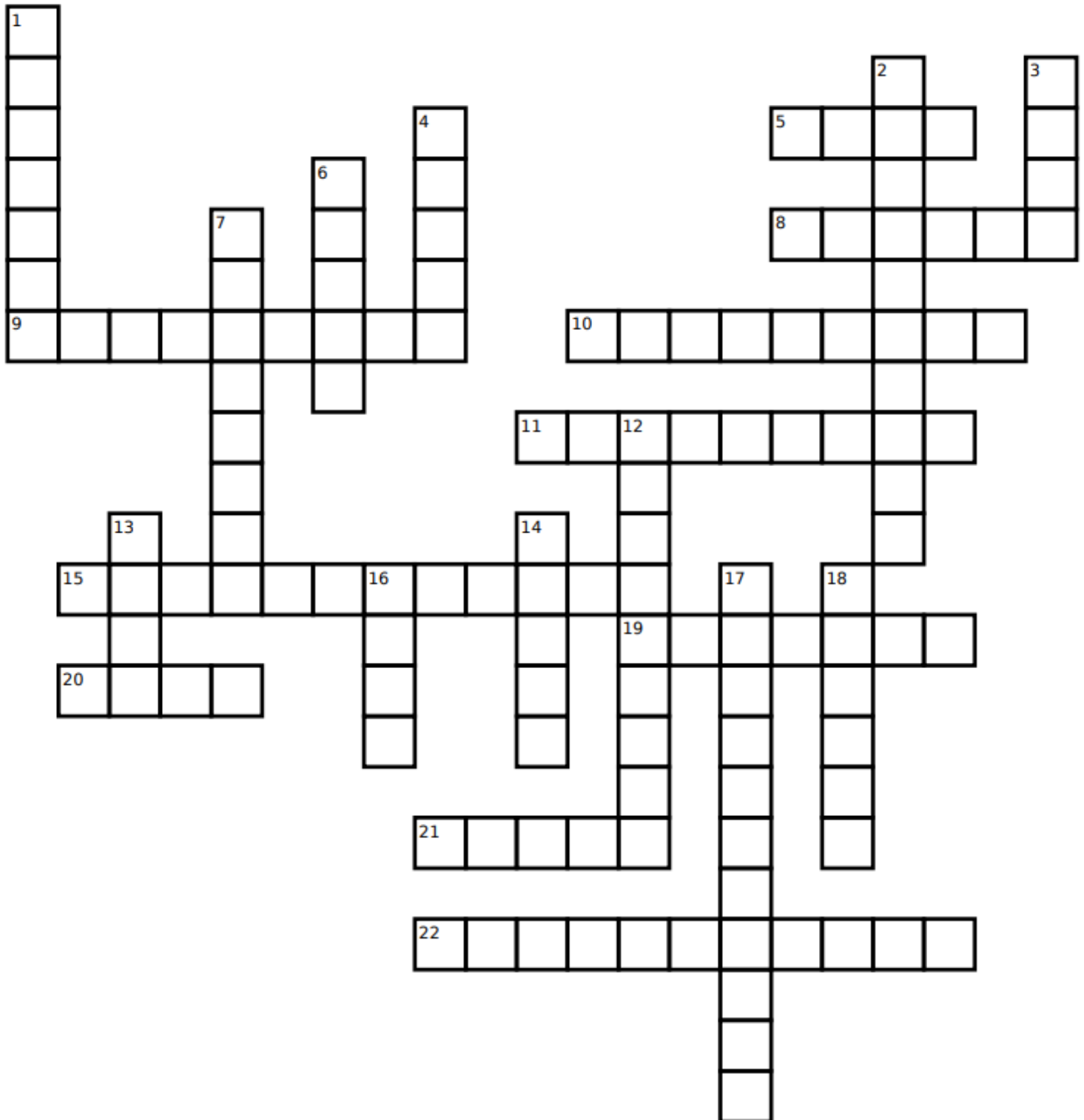

6. A glaze decoration technique where wax is applied on top of glaze, a needle tool is used to scratch the surface, and then a contrasting glaze is painted into the scratches.
