

A Proposal to enact a Law.

[i]Constituent Assembly[/i]

1. The Delegate will appoint an Electoral Commission with the consent of the Speaker and Chief Justice.
2. The Constituent Assembly will be elected November 1, 2011.
3. Should the Constituent Assembly submit a constitution for ratification and that constitution fail, new elections of the Constituent Assembly will be held for the week following the failure using the same Electoral Commission.
4. The Constituent Assembly will consist of **five** | **seven** nations.
5. Nations of the North Pacific with between **50%** | **35%** and 85% of the Delegate's endorsements will be eligible to declare candidacy.
6. The Delegate and Vice Delegate may not be candidates.
7. Any World Assembly Nation of the North Pacific, or Regional Assembly member with an identified foreign World Assembly Nation, may post a public ranked ballot on the regional message board at any time before the election, in a format specified by the Electoral Commission.
8. A foreign World Assembly nation must be identified with a link in the ballot.
9. Any World Assembly Nation of the North Pacific not voting on the regional message board will be counted before the first round of counting as voting for all of the candidates it is endorsing. Such a vote will be split equally between the candidates the nation is endorsing.
10. The quota is the number of voters divided by **six** | **eight**.
11. At the beginning of any round of counting any candidate with more votes than the quota will be elected.
12. Any ballots whose first choice has been elected will have a fractional value proportional to the candidate's surplus (that is the number of votes for the candidate more than the quota, divided by the quota) transferred to their first choice who has not yet been elected or eliminated.
