

Garden Meadow Gate Fold Card Instructions

Cutting Instructions

- Blueberry Bushel CS: 10"x 5-½" scored at 2" and 3-½", on both long ends, (1) 8-½"x ½" for belly band
- Balmy Blue CS: 4-¼"x 2-¾"
- Very Vanilla CS: 5-¼"x 2-¾", 3-¼"x 2", 3-¾"x 1-¼"
- DSP: (2) 5-¼"x 1-¾", (2) 5-¼"x 1-¼"

Assembly Instructions

1. Score and fold the Blueberry Bushel CS on the fold lines so that you have Mountain, valley, valley, mountain. Make sure the mountain folds meet in the center when you do the valley folds.
2. Adhere the 5-¼"x 1-¾" pieces of DSP to each end and the 5-¼"x 1-¼" pieces to each of the small inside panels.
3. Stamp your sentiment and the small flowers on the 5-¼"x 2-¾" piece of Very Vanilla CS, color the flowers and then glue to the inside center panel.
4. Stamp your sentiment on the 3-¼"x 2" piece of Very Vanilla CS so that it is in portrait position and then emboss it with the Exposed Brick 3D folder.
5. Die cut the 4-¼"x 2-¾" piece of Balmy Blue CS using the die from the Scalloped Contours die set. Glue the above Very Vanilla sentiment piece to the center of your Balmy Blue piece.
6. Put adhesive on the back of the left side only of the Balmy Blue die cut and adhere it to the outside left front panel so it is in the center of your card front.
7. Stamp a basket of flowers and the tall flower image to the 3-¾"x 1-¼" piece of Very Vanilla CS, color them with the blends, and then die cut them out. Adhere the tall flower to the lower left side of the front panel.
8. Wrap the belly band around the card so that it overlaps in the front and glue it together. Glue the basket of flowers to the center of the belly band.

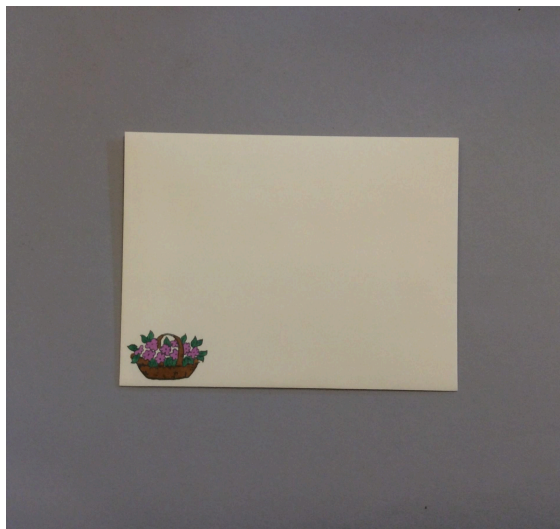
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9. Add some butterflies to the front of your card to finish it off.
10. Stamp a basket of flowers to the bottom left corner of the front of your envelope and color it. Make sure you put something inside the

envelope so that the blends don't bleed through to the back of your envelope.
