## Tips for conferences....

- If a student has a poor grade, make sure his/her parents are aware of that prior to walking in the door.
- 2. Clearly express that you want to help their child succeed. It is more effective to work with parents than against them.
- 3. Dress professionally.
- 4. Listen to parents. While you are the expert, parents want to feel that you value their input.
- 5. Provide every parent with a document that provides relevant information and can be used as a guide for the conference. For example:
  - a. Contact Information (voicemail, email)
  - b. Grading Scale/Late Work Policy
  - c. Classroom Expectations
  - d. Tentative Pacing Guide
  - e. Suggestions/Tips to improve a grade in class.
