HOW TO HELP A FAMILY MEMBER IF HE OR SHE FALLS DOWN AND GETS HURT - 1st Step

- a. Be calm and don't move the person because it might make the injury worse.
- b. Scream loudly so that the person knows you are upset.
- c. Move the person to a couch so they will feel more comfortable.

HOW TO HELP A FAMILY MEMBER IF HE OR SHE FALLS DOWN AND GETS HUR - 2nd Step

- a. Stay next to the person and do not bother to call 911.
- b. GET HELP! If there is someone in the house, yard, or nearby, send them to call 911 and get help. Call 911 yourself if no one else is there.
- c. Put the person in a wheelbarrow and take them to the hospital.

HOW TO HELP A FAMILY MEMBER IF HE OR SHE FALLS DOWN AND GETS HURT- 3rd Step

- a. Stay with the injured person. Use a blanket to keep him or her warm.
- b. Leave the person alone and go watch TV while you wait for the ambulance to arrive.
- c. Go wait outside and leave the person by himself with a good book.

HOW TO HELP SOMEONE WHOSE CLOTHES CATCH ON FIRE - 1st Step

- a. Tell the person to jump around until the flames go out.
- b. Usually the person will start to run -- stop him!
- c. Sit there and do nothing.

HOW TO HELP SOMEONE WHOSE CLOTHES CATCH ON FIRE - 2nd Step

- a. If you catch the person, force him to the ground. Roll the victim to smother the flames.
- b. Wrap them in a rug, towel, or sweater working from the neck down.
- c. If you can't stop them yell, "Stop! Stop!" and throw yourself on the ground and roll as an example. Cover your face so the victim will too.

HOW TO HELP SOMEONE WHOSE CLOTHES CATCH ON FIRE - 3rd Step

- a. As soon as you can, help the person get to a place where the burned parts of the body can be covered with clean dressing and treated by a doctor.
- b. Tell them to go take a shower and relax.
- c. Try to treat the burn yourself. Why bother with a doctor?

HOW TO HELP YOURSELF IF YOUR CLOTHES CATCH ON FIRE - 1st Step

- a. Stop where you are. DON'T RUN!
- b. Find the nearest pool and jump in.
- c. Go to a friend's house to get help.

HOW TO HELP YOURSELF IF YOUR CLOTHES CATCH ON FIRE - 2nd Step

- a. Drop to the floor or ground and sit there and wait for help.
- b. Drop to the floor or ground and roll and cover your face.
- c. If you are indoors, grab a rug, blanket, or coat and wrap yourself as you roll. Start at your neck.

HOW TO HELP YOURSELF IF YOUR CLOTHES CATCH ON FIRE - Summary

- a. Stop, rock, and roll.
- b. Stop, drop, and roll.
- c. Run, swim, and play.

WHAT TO DO IF YOUR HOUSE CATCHES ON FIRE - 1st Step

- a. Hide under your bed and wait for help.
- b. Hide in the closet and shut the door.
- c. Get everyone out of the house! Crawl along the floor to avoid breathing smoke.

WHAT TO DO IF YOUR HOUSE CATCHES ON FIRE - 2nd Step

- a. Try to put the fire out yourself.
- b. Don't try to put the fire out yourself.
- c. Just sit there and watch the flames.

WHAT TO DO IF YOUR HOUSE CATCHES ON FIRE - 3rd Step

- a. Call the fire department from a neighbor's house.
- b. When firefighters arrive, let them know everyone is out of the house.
- c. Remember: Never go back into a burning house for any reason.

WHAT TO DO IF A BOAT OVERTURNS AND YOU ARE IN IT - 1st Step

- a. Dive down and look for treasure.
- b. Don't panic. Grab the boat and stay with it.
- c. Panic. Scream and splash around desperately.

WHAT TO DO IF A BOAT OVERTURNS AND YOU ARE IN IT - 2nd Step

- a. Try to swim to shore as quickly as possible, no matter how far from shore you are.
- b. Help the other passengers to find a place where they can hold on. No one should try to swim ashore.
- c. Stay with the boat; it will support you. Wait for rescuers.

WHAT TO DO IF A BOAT OVERTURNS AND YOU ARE IN IT - 3rd Step

- a. If the boat can be turned right side up, get inside and sit as low as possible on the bottom.
- b. Look for fish and try to catch them.
- c. Hope that Nemo will come and lead you to shore.

WHAT TO DO IF SOMEONE SLIPS OFF A BANK INTO WATER

- a. Reach the person, if possible, with your hand or leg. Take off your sweater or shirt and toss one end to the person.
- b. Extend a stick, fishing pole, branch, or anything that is handy.
- c. Throw something to the person that will float, such as a cushion, inner tube, plank, or ring buoy, if available.

WHAT TO DO IF SOMEONE FALLS THROUGH THE ICE - 1st Step

- a. Run across the ice to help and hope you don't fall in too.
- b. Remember, if you get too close, you might break through too.
- c. Walk really slowly toward the person.

WHAT TO DO IF SOMEONE FALLS THROUGH THE ICE - 2nd Step

- a. Find something to throw to the person.
- b. Look around for a ladder, a long branch, or anything you can use to reach the person.
- c. Run around like crazy and panic.

WHAT TO DO IF SOMEONE FALLS THROUGH THE ICE - 3rd Step

- a. After you find a ladder, branch, etc., lie flat on safe ice and push the item toward the person until he can grab it. Then you can pull him out.
- b. You climb on the ladder or branch until you can grab the person's hand.
- c. When the person is out of the water, get him to someplace warm.

WHAT TO DO IN CASE OF A SCHOOL BUS ACCIDENT - 1st Step

- a. Always goof around on the bus and don't bother looking for the exits, because who cares?
- b. Always know where emergency exits are whenever you get on a bus.
- c. Just don't take the bus.

WHAT TO DO IN CASE OF A SCHOOL BUS ACCIDENT - 2nd Step

- a. In case of accident, stay calm, and follow directions from driver.
- b. If driver is injured, stay calm.
- c. Start screaming and crying and shoving.

WHAT TO DO IN CASE OF A SCHOOL BUS ACCIDENT - 3rd Step

- a. Stay in your seat and cry and whine.
- b. Get out of the bus through the emergency exits. Help others. Do not push.
- c. Move to the side of the road, away from traffic.

WHAT TO DO IN CASE OF A CAR ACCIDENT - 1st Step

- a. Jump out of the car and run around in the middle of the street.
- b. Be calm. Help the adults by doing what you are told.
- c. Scream hysterically and don't listen to the adults.

WHAT TO DO IN CASE OF A CAR ACCIDENT - 2nd Step

- a. Tell the driver that the car can be left where it is until the police come.
- b. Ask an adult to direct traffic around the car.
- c. Try to push the car out of the road.

WHAT TO DO IN CASE OF A CAR ACCIDENT - 3rd Step

- a. Run out in the middle of the street and scream.
- b. Don't go out into the road yourself. Watch for other cars. All passengers should get out of the car on the side away from traffic.
- c. Don't move anyone who might be badly injured.
