Sarah's Preemie Hat



This beautiful little baby hat was created by my Sister-in-law, Sarah. I've worked it up into a simple and quick pattern here.

Materials:

I skein worsted or fingering weight yarn US Size 6 DPNS (4 needles)

Ribbing:

- Cast 60 stitches onto 3 of the DPN's (20 stitches per needle.)
- Using remaining DPN, work in K2P2 rib for 5 rounds

Body:

- Knit 5 rounds
- Purl 1 round
- Knit 5 Rounds
- Purl 1 round
- Knit 5 rounds

Decreasing:

- P3, P2tog (repeat till end of round)
- Knit 4 rounds
- P2, P2tog (repeat till end of round)
- Knit 4 rounds
- P1, P2tog (repeat till end of round)
- Knit 4 rounds
- P2tog, P2tog (repeat till end of round)
- Knit 3 rounds
- P2tog,P2tog (repeat till end of round)

Finishing:

• Cut tail, use a tapestry needle and thread the tail through the remaining stitches. Pull tight and tie off.
