



Each of these designs demonstrate a different aspect of balance and symmetry. The top one is asymmetrically balanced, as it is the same shape just different colors and not able to be split down the middle. The second one is radially balanced, able to be split in fourths and each fourth be the same. The last one is regularly symmetrically balanced, when you split it down the middle the two halves are the same. Knowing this different kinds of balances and knowing when to use them in your work is key.
