BIO GUIDANCE

PLEASE FOLLOW THIS GUIDANCE WHEN CREATING YOUR BIO:

1. BIO's are to be short and fit on one page preferably less than **150 words**. This is the information that will be shared when you are presented to the club at one of the monthly meetings. **Along with your picture** this BIO will also appear in one the monthly newsletters.
2. To the extent, you wish to share your BIO should cover the following:
 - a. Personal information like birth year, birth city, schools / education, where you have lived
 - b. Career information like which company and when you retired, brief mention of other companies you worked for and / or positions which you held.
 - c. Family information like married to who, # of children, # of grandchildren
 - d. Your interests, hobbies and/or travel which you have done
3. This is meant to be used as guidance only as your BIO should reflect the information you would like to share with other members of the club.
4. Prior to you being presented to the other members of the club your BIO will be reviewed by the Membership Chair. If changes are required the Membership Chair will get in touch with you.
