


Insert a quiz in a Kaltura video

Kaltura lets you insert questions anywhere in your video to quiz your student before they can continue watching the video.

1. In your Brightspace course, go to **Tools** and then open **My Media**





2. Find the video you would like to edit/upload captions to and click on the **pencil icon** to the right of the video:



3. In the new window, click **Launch Editor**




4. Click on the **Quiz icon** (cube icon) in the top left corner and then click **Start**. As noted, a copy of the media will be created and the original media will stay intact.



5. Expand **Details, Score, and Experience** for more options

6. Put the marker anywhere on the timeline of the video at the bottom and click **Add a Question** for a question to pop up at that particular time.



7. When finished adding questions and changing options, click **Done** in the top right. The copy of the original video with the quiz will appear at the top of your My Media list.
