The Parade:

Coaches and players should meet at 9- 9:15 am at St. Theresa's Church. The address is 21370 St Theresa Ln, Ashburn. Players should wear their full uniform and sneakers. It is best for everyone to be dropped off, or walk, to the church as there is no parking along the parade route or at the church. Please allow extra time.

Once players have met up with their teams at the church, parents and families should head to the parade route to cheer on the teams as they pass. Please encourage neighbors and fans to come cheer as well! Parents are not allowed to walk the route with the team, and will be able to meet up with their children after the ceremony at Crittenden.

THERE IS NO PARKING at St. Theresa's. There is a wedding that morning and they will be towing cars. Parents should drop their players with their coaches.

The parade will begin at 9:30 am.

Parking:

Crossroads United Methodist Church, 43454 Crossroads Dr, Ashburn, VA 20147.
Ashburn Farm HOA Parking Lot
Junction Plaza Shopping Center
DO NOT park along the parade route.

Parking at Crittenden Field is reserved for our Challengers Families only.

Celebration:

The celebration will be at Crittenden Park from 9:30am - 2 pm, following the parade. We will start with our traditional Opening Day ceremony that takes place on Crittenden field #1. Afterwards there will be food trucks, Kona Ice, bounce houses and activities for all ages. Plan for a fun family day and have lunch at the ballpark!

Team Banner Contest:

Each team (T-ball - Majors) is able to enter our annual team banner contest. Only homemade banners will be eligible for the Team Spirit Banner Contest. The winning team from each division (T-Ball through Majors) will receive a \$100 gift card for use at their end of season party. See attachment for examples of banners from past contests.

Materials recommended: Felt or other cloth (various sizes), glue gun, markers, sharp scissors, pole, styrofoam baseballs, felt letters, spray paint, and lots of other stuff at Michael's.

The size of the banner will depend on the height of your kids, so don't make it too tall for your kids to carry during the parade or the coaches will have to carry it (they will end up doing it anyway). After Opening day you can bring the banner to your games and hang it on the dugout fence with a few carabiners.
