Functionality & Purpose> Rating-

- What is the tool designed to do (purpose)? How well does it fulfill its intended purpose?
- How well does it work as you interact with it? How easy is it to figure out what to do?
- How smoothly can you use the parts/tools inside the app? Is there any lagging as you move objects or between screens?

Access (Platforms)> Rating-

- Which platform does the tool work on? IOS - Android - Computer Browser
- If it works on your device and on a browser, how well does it "sync" information?

Visuals> Rating-

- How attractive are the interfaces (the pages/screens)?
- How busy are the pages/screens?
- How appealing are the colors and text choice?

Sounds (Audio)> If there are sounds. Rating-

- How clear is the audio in general?
- If there is speaking, is there also distracting background music?

Saving and Sharing> If the tool lets you create then you want to be able to save and possibly share your creation. Sometimes you have to adapt and take a screen capture that can be saved as an image file. Rating-

- Are you able to easily save a copy of your creation to a storage place (ex. Drive, DropBox)?
- Are you able to easily share a copy of your creation with others?
- Are you able to work with others on the same project (collaborate) when using this tool?
