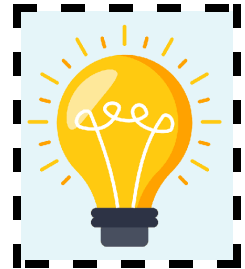

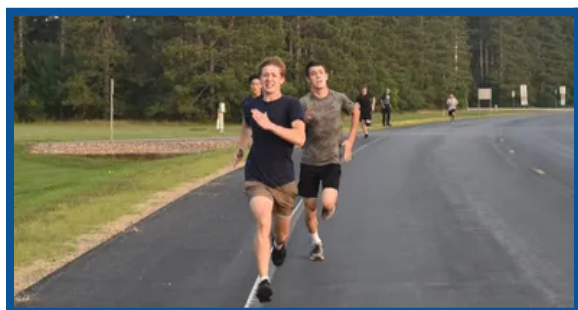
finished, you need to either report to the cafeteria for lunch (optional) or leave the building.
