



Z Safety Flag and Mount Kit

INSTALLATION GUIDE

Thank you for choosing [Cruzbike](https://cruzbike.com) and the Z Safety Flag and Mount Kit. The movement of the flag helps keep riders visible on the roads we share with automobiles. We sell our reflective flag with a beautifully designed mounting system created by Terracycle.

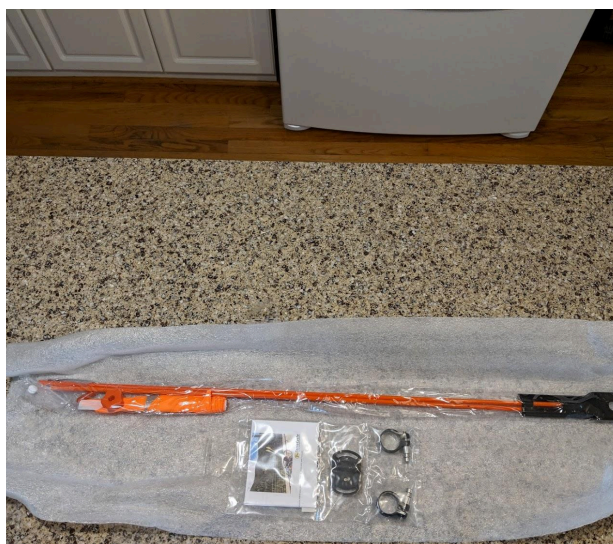
The flag can be mounted in several places on the bike. On the V20, S40 and we like to mount it on the rear seat support or rear fork of the frame. On the Q45 and T50 it can go on the seat support of either bike.

Tools Required

Scissors, 4mm allen wrench, 3mm allen wrench

Installation

Open the flag (**first image below**) Discard black metal mount (**second image below**). It can go under the quick release of the rear wheel, but is not the safest way to mount the flag.

The small orange cap (**first image below**) goes on the top of the flag pole to keep the flag from flying off the top. The small black zip-tie should be fastened tightly around the pole just beneath the bottom of the flag to keep it from sliding down (**second image below**). Alternately a small dab of super glue can be used to keep the flag in place.



Open up the Terracycle Safety flag mount. There are instructions for installing the mount on your bicycle included. It is important to use the right sized clamps for your bike. The clamps are installed with a 4mm allen. Below are images of the mount installed with the small clamps on the seat support of the S40.



Once the clamp is installed, you can push the flag pole into it (**first image below**) and tighten the bolt head on the flange with a 3mm allen wrench. This tightens down on the pole assuring it stays in place.

For use on the back of a Cruzbike, we combine the two sections of the pole (**second image below**) so that the flag is well above the bike.



For installation on the back on the Q45 or the T50. We install the flag on the seatpost. It is possible to use only half the flag.

You're all set! Enjoy safe cycling!
