Club Overview and Content

Model United Nations is an authentic simulation of the UN General Assembly and other multilateral bodies such as the UN Security Council, the International Atomic Energy Agency, the International Court of Justice and the European Union, as well as national cabinets. Simulations are both current day and historic.

Model UN gives students a chance to learn about different countries, increase their awareness of international relations and the United Nations and most importantly to think critically about issues from multiple perspectives. At a Model UN conference, students play the role of diplomats and work with other delegates from high schools around the world to devise solutions to some of the most pressing global issues. Through these experiences, students develop such academic and life skills as research, writing, public speaking, consensus building, conflict resolution, compromise and cooperation. Model UN students often go on to become great leaders in politics, law, business, education, and even medicine.

Club Schedule

Weekly Meetings

Students participate in 1 hour club meetings to learn about the workings of the UN and prepare for upcoming Model UN conferences. The faculty advisor and student leaders will guide the MUN team members with training and practice on their public speaking, debating, research, negotiation, resolution-writing and diplomacy skills. Activities will also include discussion of current events, practicing parliamentary procedure, running practice simulations and perhaps hosting mini-conferences with other high schools.

- Experience in international relations is not required. Anyone with the ambition to learn something new and work with people to try and make a difference in the world are welcome to participate.
