

Vowel Team & Vowel-r BINGO

Directions:

*Materials needed per game: Color printer
3 pages card stock
2 clear sheet protectors
2 dri-erase markers
1 snack size zip-lock bag*

Print on card stock 1 game board of each color for the game you want to use, then print 1 extra board.

Slip the two boards of different colors into clear sheet protectors.

Cut the extra board into small cards by trimming away borders and cut apart the squares with words in them. Store in snack size zip-lock bag.

Mix the small cards and place on table face down. The first player turns over the top card and identifies the Vowel Team sound (i.e.” /i/ the 3 letter /i/” *if the word is night*; or “/er/ as in nurse” *if playing Vowel-r and the word is turn*) and then reads the word. If this is correct that player may draw a diagonal across that word on their board using a dri-erase marker. *If not correct, the other player may say the sound and word and mark their board.* The second player then turns over the next card and play continues until one player has marked five squares in a row and calls “BINGO!”

Markings are easily wiped away with a tissue for next game.

Virtual Play

This game is easily played virtually when each player has a set of both game boards in protectors, a set of cards, and a dri-erase marker. Once connected on Zoom, players decide who will play which color of board (must be different) and who will turn over and display the cards.
