US-RSE Rapid Interview Instructions

We want to know more about the members of the US-RSE! The US-RSE Outreach Working Group is collecting rapid interviews from its members for use at events such as Supercomputing, eScience, etc. If you are interested in submitting a rapid interview, please follow these instructions:

- 1. Use a recording program of your choice to capture video and audio of yourself.
- 2. Pull up the <u>questions</u> document.
- 3. Record your answer to each outer bullet point. Try to keep answers brief, about 30 seconds each.
- 4. Name the file
 - a. FamilyName GivenName Question.*
 - b. With the following mapping from full question to suffix:
 - i. "Tell us about you..." -> About_Me
 - ii. "What are you working on right now..." -> Current_Work
 - iii. "How did you hear about RSEs and US-RSE?" -> How_USRSE
 - iv. "Why did you join the US-RSE?" -> Why_USRSE
 - v. "Describe your work as an RSE or RSE ally in one sentence." -> Describe_Work
 - vi. "Where would you like to see the RSE profession in 10 years?" -> Ten Years
 - c. Example:
 - i. Teves_Joshua_About_Me.mov would be a clip from Joshua Teves answering the question, "Tell us about you..." with all sub-questions.
- 5. In the Google Drive path <u>US-RSE Outreach Materials > New Submissions > Rapid Interviews</u>, make a folder with your family name, and place all recording files there.
- 6. Fill out the <u>US-RSE Rapid Interview Consent Form</u>.
