Updated March 21st, 2025 to include the information regarding the second warning.

Hello all,

On March 19th, 2025, the Chief Returning Officer received reports and evidence that Amogh Manivannan failed to blur the Onyx Logo in their campaign material.

This is in direct violation of Bylaw 3, 8.3.7 b) which prohibits the "Usage of any logo in a candidate's campaign material" As a result, the candidate in question will be issued a formal warning which will be displayed on the voter statement page during the voting period on vote.skule.ca.

Separately, on March 20th, 2025, the Chief Returning Officer gathered evidence that Amogh Manivannan failed to put vote.skule.ca in their campaign material.

This is in direct violation of Bylaw 3, 8.0.2 which states all campaign materials must prominently display "vote.skule.ca." It was also very clearly reiterated multiple times in the <u>ACM</u> that each piece of campaign material must have vote.skule.ca. As a result, the candidate in question will be issued a formal warning which will be displayed on the voter statement page during the voting period on vote.skule.ca.

These decisions may be appealed under the process outlined in <u>Bylaw 3</u>, <u>section 10</u>.
