

Privacy Policy for ClickUp Automer Extension

Last updated: December 2025

This Privacy Policy describes how the ClickUp Automer Chrome extension (“the Extension”) handles user data.

1. Data Collection

The Extension does not collect, store, transmit, or share any personal or sensitive user data. All user-defined schedules, settings, and preferences are stored locally in the user’s browser using Chrome’s storage APIs and never leave the user’s device.

2. Permissions Usage

The Extension requests the following permissions solely to fulfill its single purpose:

- `storage`: To save user preferences and scheduled tasks locally.
- `alarms`: To trigger scheduled actions at user-defined times.
- `scripting`: To inject scripts required to automate actions on the ClickUp Web App.
- Host Permissions (`app.clickup.com`): To operate only on the ClickUp Web App and identify the active ClickUp tab for automation.

These permissions are not used for tracking, analytics, or data collection.

3. Third-Party Access

The Extension does not sell, transfer, or share user data with any third parties. No external servers, analytics tools, or remote code are used.

4. Remote Code

The Extension does not use remote JavaScript, WebAssembly, or dynamically loaded code. All functionality is included within the packaged extension.

5. User Control

Users may remove the Extension at any time through the Chrome Extensions page, which deletes all locally stored data automatically.

6. Changes to This Policy

This Privacy Policy may be updated if the Extension's functionality changes. Any updates will be reflected on this page.
