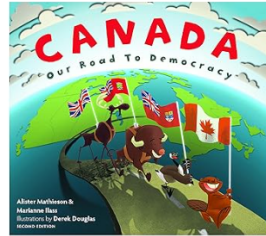
Time and Place - Exploring the dynamic relationships between people, place and time supports understanding of perspectives and events to make meaning of the world.
