

Eclipse and Java Cheat Sheet

*Note that when it is written Ctrl+A, it means to hold down the Ctrl key and then press the A key

****Note that on a mac computer the Command key is used instead of Ctrl key**

To indent your code correctly in Eclipse:

Ctrl+A - Select All

Ctrl+I - Indent

To write the `System.out.println()` statement:

Type syso then Ctrl+spacebar

To select a line of code:

Triple click the left mouse button

To select a word - or variable:

Double click the left mouse button

To copy and paste:

Ctrl+C to copy and Ctrl+V to paste, and Ctrl+X if you want to cut instead of copy

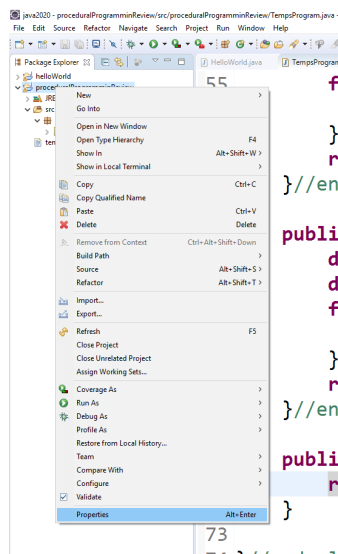
To undo something:

Ctrl+Z - and keep hitting Ctrl+Z to back up multiple steps

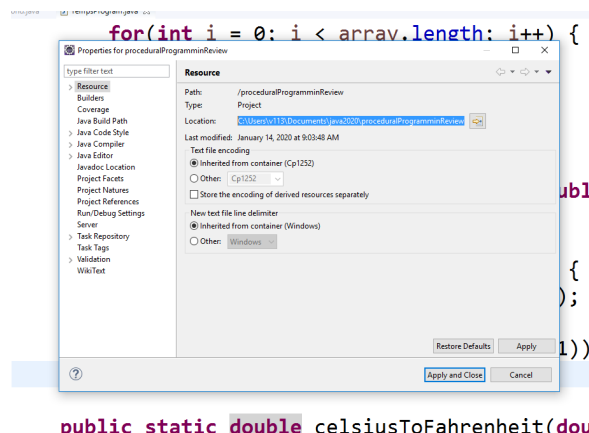
To save:

Ctrl+S

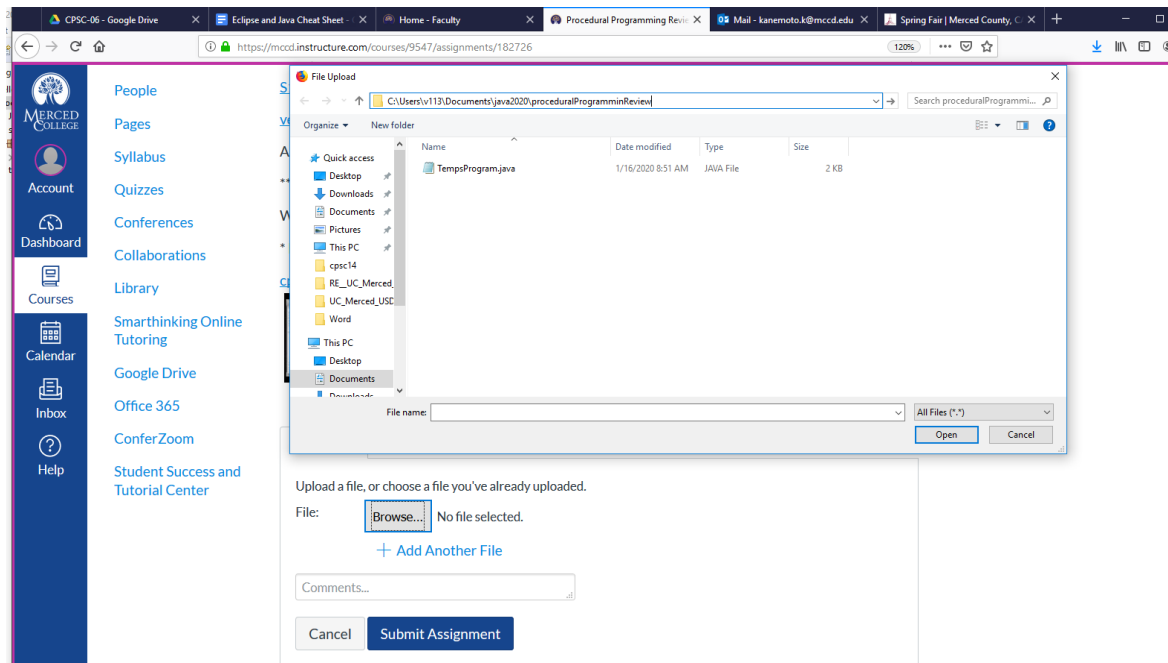
To turn in your JAVA file:



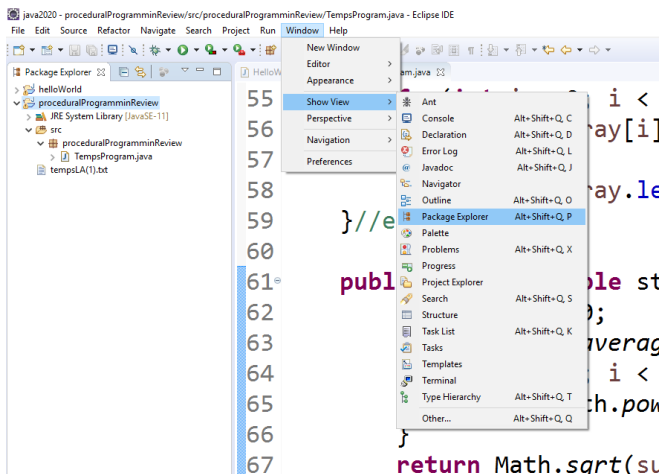
Right click your project and go to Properties, then copy the address of where the project is



Then go to the upload button and paste this address into the white bar at the top to go to the location of your project - remember that the JAVA file is located in the src folder:



If any part of Eclipse “disappears”:



Go to Window → Show View → and then click on the part that you would like to see
