

FATBLUDRAGON TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The pronoun "You" in the terms refers to the client.

The pronoun "I" in the terms refers to the artist.

The pronoun "We" in the terms refers to both the client and the artist.

"Note:" paragraphs and any text in the same format as this sentence are comments by the artist and are not part of the terms and conditions.

By paying the invoice, you hereby agree to the following terms:

The service provided to create the artwork is refundable, as elaborated in the refund policy. However, the final artwork at completion or cancellation is considered "as is" and is not eligible for refunds due to dissatisfaction with the artistic style, interpretation, or any other subjective preferences.

PAYMENT POLICY

If the buyer's purchase is from a country in the EU, 19% VAT is included in the price total. It is not added on top of the settled price. The commission must be paid upfront and will only start, once (partial) payment has been received.

If the payment is partial, the commission will be completed up to the percentage of the completed payment. For example, a 50% partial payment will result in a 50% completed commission.

If multiple people pay for the invoice, then everyone will receive the same one and they can partially pay their contribution. Tips will not count toward the regular payment, thus you don't pay for someone else with your tip.

PROCESS

During the commission, you will receive chances for feedback multiple times during the process. These moments are during the following phases: Conceptualization (rough sketch), fine sketch, lineart, lighting, and finalization. I will wait until confirmation before moving over to the next phase. During the feedback, you may suggest changes that are fitting for the phase. You may not suggest changes you should have asked for before. Examples for fitting revisions for each phase may include but are not exclusive to:

Conceptualization:	concept, idea
Fine Sketch:	expressions, character details, pose, body shape
Lineart:	missing details minimal changes to pose, expression, and shape
Lighting:	color and direction of light and shadows
Finalization:	background, filters, flat colors (I always add flat colors last)

This is not the case for "Your character here" Commissions (YCH). In these kinds of commissions, you only receive an edit sketch (not guaranteed) or finalization for feedback as only the character in the scene is changed while the pose and concept remain the same. If only the finalization provides feedback, you can ask changes for to the character design or details.

Insisting on a change that should have been requested earlier will require a compensation fee based on the effort "wasted" yet at least 20% of the total price.

At the end of the process, given you confirmed any changes during feedback, you agree that you are satisfied with the service and commission.

REFUND

Both you and I have the right to cancel the commission at any time before and during the process without the need for justification.

If you'd like to cancel the commission, you may issue a refund. If the commission hasn't started yet, then you'll receive a full refund. If a refund is issued after the start, then the amount of refund is relative to which phase has been completed. The percentage refunded based on the commission phase is the following:

Conceptualization:	100%
Fine Sketch:	80%
Lineart:	50%
(Flat coloring: 30%):	30%
Lighting:	10%
Finalization:	0%

For example, if you refund a commission after flat coloring has been completed, then you'll receive 30% back. You will also get the unfinished commission as the most recent work in progress (WIP).

After finalization, as mentioned in the process, you agree to be fully satisfied with the service. You'll receive the final artwork "as is", thus you won't have the option for a refund.

DISTRIBUTION AND COPYRIGHT

As of § 29(1) of UrhG (German copyright law), I am legally unable to transfer copyright directly to you. However, you may receive a worldwide, exclusive license to use the artwork in any non-commercial way with the following conditions:

- Credit needs to be given when posting the artwork on public platforms such as Twitter, FurAffinity, Twitch, or Discord
- Any exported file may be shared.

I reserve the right to use and distribute the artwork commercially. However, I'll refrain from using the final artwork for deviated services, such as "Your character here" (YCH) commissions unless otherwise agreed to or opted out by you. I also provide non-exclusive rights of use for everyone to share the artwork on private platforms, such as Discord, and e621.net with proper credit to both of us. You may request the rights of use to be changed.

Note: You can ask not to be credited to keep the commission private altogether.

The rights of use licenses are subject to change! Any addition or removal of rights will be listed in the item description of the invoice.

- Examples of changes may include but are not exclusive to:
- Royalty-free rights of use for commercial purposes
- Changes to distribution forms
- Prohibition of attribution
- Changes to the non-exclusive license

If the item description contains "**WFW - Only post in 18+ spaces!**" (short for "Weird for Work"), you may only share the artwork in spaces that are declared mature. Examples of such platforms may be but are not exclusive to:

- Furaffinity "mature" or "adult" rating
- Discord servers or channels for adults only
- 18+ indicators in social media or streams

Note: These commissions are not necessarily NSFW or sexual. However, I feel extremely uncomfortable with the notion that minors can see the art I deem unfit.

Definition of WFW (Weird for Work):

Content may abide by upload policies of websites to be shared without restricting it to adults only, but may not be suitable for minors between 13 and 18 years old to consume. Content that is argued to be "technically SFW" falls under the category.

If the item description contains "Void Commission" then your exclusive rights of use change to the following condition: You may use the artwork in any non-commercial way privately. You may not post it on a public platform except for personal Discord servers. You also may not give credit to me as I want to remain anonymous.

Any violation of the rights of use license and refusal to cooperate may result in actions taken against you and prohibiting you from buying future commissions (blacklisting)
