An ASUCD Senate Bill to update the requirements around the Budgetary Seminar.

BACKGROUND: As elected representatives, ASUCD Senators bear a responsibility to be fully informed of the budgetary process and the Budgetary Seminar is one institutionalized way for senators to understand the budgetary process and policy. Currently, Section 2708(A)(2) requires this Budgetary Seminar to be held on a Saturday (or a different date at the discretion of the ASUCD Controller). In the spirit of encouraging work-life balance, this bill changes the default day for the Budgetary Seminar to a weekday as well as requiring it be held at least twice.

Section 1. The ASUCD Senate hereby amends Section 2708(A)(2) of the ASUCD Bylaws as follows:

- (2) **Budgetary Seminar:** ~~This seminar shall be held on campus on a Saturday at least two (2) times during winter or spring quarter prior to budget hearings, with the though a different date or location determined may be scheduled~~ at the discretion of the ASUCD Controller. It shall focus on Long-Range Plans, the budgeting process, and ASUCD policies and structure. A discussion of the problems and perceptions of ASUCD and any other relevant topics should be conducted. A management training session may also be given. Exercises to develop individual management skills and team building should be included.
