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PROPERTY MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT

PAN REAL ESTATE PRIVATE LIMITED

AND

This Property Management Agreement (the "Agreement") is made and effective 2016.

BETWEEN: (The "Owners") holding Maldivian National Identity Card Number A-..... (The "Owners") and having permanent address at **MALE', REP. OF MALDIVES.**

AND: **PAN REAL ESTATE PRIVATE LIMITED** (the "Agent"), a company incorporated in the Republic of Maldives having address at **SHINETREE BUILDING -3RD FLOOR, BODUTHAKURUFAANU MAGU, MALE' MALDIVES**, having Registration Number: **C-742/2009.**

RECITALS

Owners hold title to the following-described real Property:

Property here referred to as the Property.

Owners desire to engage the services of Agent to manage and operate the Property, and Agent desires to provide such services on the following terms and conditions.

In consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties agree:

EMPLOYMENT OF AGENT

Agent shall act as the exclusive Agent of Owners to manage, operate and maintain the Property.

BEST EFFORTS OF AGENT

On assuming the management and operation of the Property, Agent shall thoroughly inspect the Property and submit a written report to Owners. The written report shall contain the opinion of Agent concerning the present efficiency under which the Property is being managed and operated, and recommended changes, if necessary, in the management structure of the Property, in the rehabilitation of the Property, and any other matters that will improve the efficient management and operation of the Property. After conferring with Owners and obtaining approval to make any necessary improvements, Agent shall undertake completion of the improvements which shall be reimbursed by the Owners by allowing such amounts to be deducted from the rental payments payable to the Owned under section 3.1(e) of this Agreement.

SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE AGENT

3.1 All of the following services shall be provided by the Agent.

Routine inspection

Agent will visit the leased properties for routine inspections. Agent will oversee the status of each of the undertakings agreed by the Owners and Tenants.

Evacuation of tenants

Agent will facilitate the eviction of tenants from properties with the approval and instruction from Owners. The Agent may also facilitate legal proceedings for the recovery of unpaid rent from tenants. The Owners will be notified prior of such legal expenses by the Agent and once approved, shall be bared by the Owners.

Cleaning of Common areas

Agent will arrange to clean the common areas of properties; this includes the lift, walkways, corridors, terrace and the entrance 3x (three times) per week

Rent Collection

Agent will arrange to collect rent from properties and transfer it to the Owners no later than the 15th day of each month and provide statements or receipts of such said transactions.

Cleaning of Property

All apartments will be thoroughly cleaned at the end of each tenancy; this work will include paint touch ups, minor putty work, light changes and vacuum cleaning. The Owners will be notified of the cleaning charges before the work takes place and at the approval of the Owners, the Agent shall undertake such cleaning services. The Owners shall be liable for such expenses.

Website Marketing

The Agent shall advertise the Property on the internet. This will be mainly done by posting a page per Property, which consists of feature pictures of the Property, an article describing vital information's and a marked map for location.

In addition, Agent has released two more services for the client of an advertising Property.

High lighting a best picture for the website front page slideshow.

Including floor plans to give a more detail description of the Property setting.

Printed poster distribution

Attractively designed A4 and A3 printed posters will be made for distribution amongst the government and private sectors of Male'. The quantity is determined between 15 - 30 pieces.

Security Guard

The Agent shall provide the property, a security guard, that will look after the premises at predefined times by the Agent.

Security Guard duties are as follows:

Ensure safety and security of the property
Cleaning of common area
Collection of the utility bills and distribution

Furthermore, the security guard is an employee of the Agent and is not required to used other than that of his stated duties by the Tenants or Owner for any purpose.

3.2 Rent/Deposit/Advance

Security Deposit: The Owners acknowledges that the Agent is entitled to collect an amount equivalent to 1 month's rent from all of the tenants under the tenancy agreements between the Agent and the tenants. This security deposit shall remain with the Agent throughout the term of tenancy of the tenants. The Owners further acknowledges that the security deposit will be returned to the tenants by the Agent after expenses for maintenance and repairs are done for the leased premises.

Advance Rent: The Agent shall collect 02 (TWO) month advance rent from all of the tenants. The 01 (ONE) months' rent shall be retained by the Agent as Agent's Fee and 01 (ONE) month's rent shall be deposited to the Trust Account stipulated under this

Agreement. The Agent is entitled to the Agent's fee of 01 (ONE) month's rent each time a new tenancy agreement is entered into.

Obligations for repairs

Owners' Repairs: The Owners shall be required to repair defects, deficiencies, deviations or failures of materials or workmanship in the building Property. The Owners shall keep the Property free of such defects, deficiencies, deviations or failures during the term hereof.

Tenant's Repairs: The Agent shall cause the repair and maintains the Property in good order and condition, except for reasonable wear and tear, and maintenance or replacement necessitated as the result of the act or omission or negligence of the Tenant, its employees, by deducting such amounts from the one month deposit held with the Agent. In the event the cost of such repairs or maintenance exceeds the amount deposited, the Agent shall require the tenants to deposit the shortfall with the Agent.

Leasing of the Units

Agent shall make reasonable efforts to lease available space of the property, and shall be responsible for all negotiations with prospective tenants. Agent shall also have the right to execute and enter into, on behalf of Owners, month-to-month tenancies of units of the property. Agent may negotiate all extensions and renewals of such month-to-month tenancies and leases. Agent shall not, without the prior written consent of Owners, enter into any lease for a term less than one year or more than twenty four months. Agent shall maintain the following minimum rates when leasing out the units of the Property:

INSURANCE

Owners shall obtain the following insurance at the expense of Owners, and such insurance shall be maintained in force during the full term of this agreement. Owners may alternatively request the Agent to obtain the insurance on behalf of the Owners at an agree fee.

Comprehensive public liability Property insurance of single limit for bodily injury, death and Property damage;

Fire and extended coverage hazard insurance in an amount equal to the full replacement cost of the structure and other improvements situated on the Property; and

Owners shall deliver certificates evidencing such insurance coverage to Agent within 5 days from the issuance and renewal of the policies.

AGENT'S MANAGEMENT FEE

Agent shall be paid by the Owner, 10% (Ten percent) of each month's rent as Management Fee.

BANK ACCOUNTS

Agent shall deposit (either directly or in a depository bank for transmittal) all revenues from the Property into the general Property management trust fund of Agent, here referred to as the Trust Account. Agent shall not commingle any of the above-described revenues with any funds or other Property of Agent. From the revenues deposited in the Trust Account, Agent shall pay all items with respect to the Property for which payment is provided in this agreement, including the Management Fee of the Agent. After such payments Agent shall remit any balance of any monthly revenues to Owners.

RECORDS AND REPORTS

Agent will keep books, accounts and records that reflect all revenues and all expenditures incurred in connection with the management and operation of the Property. The books, accounts and records shall be maintained at the principal place of business of Agent. Upon written request of the Owners, the Agent shall, provide details of such records.

Within 30 days after the end of each calendar year, Agent shall prepare and deliver to Owners a detailed statement of revenues received and expenditures incurred and paid during the calendar year that result from operations of the Property.

COMMISSIONS FOR NEGOTIATING LEASES OR MONTH-TO-MONTH RENTAL AGREEMENTS

Agent shall receive no commissions or additional compensation for negotiating leases or month-to-month rental agreements with tenants, and the tenants shall not be entitled to pay any other payments in addition to monthly rents, deposits stated in this Agreement and compensation for repairs.

ADDITIONAL DUTIES AND RIGHTS OF AGENT

In addition to the foregoing, Agent shall perform all services that are necessary and proper for the operation and management of the Property, and shall report to Owners promptly any conditions concerning the Property that would reasonably require the attention of Owners.

In order to properly perform the services required by this agreement, Agent is authorized to engage, on behalf of Owners, any entity that is an affiliate of Agent, provided that the compensation paid for the services shall be competitive with nonaffiliated entities providing the same or similar services.

GOVERNMENT REGULATIONS

Agent shall manage the Property in full compliance with all laws and regulations of any federal, state, county or municipal authority having jurisdiction over the Property.

TERMINATION AND RENEWAL

This agreement shall be for a term commencing on and ending on The Owners shall have the right to terminate this Agreement upon giving **02 (TWO)** months' notice, and the Agent shall have the right to terminate this Agreement upon giving **02 (TWO)** months' notice. Upon termination of the agreement all amounts due from the Agent to the Owners and all sums remaining in the Trust Account established under this Agreement shall be transferred to the Owners within 60 business days. In no event shall the Agent be required to return or reimburse the Agent's Commission of the 1st month's rent from the tenants or any of the Agent's Commission that has been earned by the Agent.

SALE OF PROPERTY

On the voluntary sale of the Property by Owners and the delivery of the deed of conveyance therefore, this agreement shall automatically terminate. Owners shall notify Agent of the sale of the Property as soon as such sale is negotiated.

RELATIONSHIP OF THE PARTIES

Agent is an independent contractor and not an employee of Owners for any purpose.

NOTICE

All notices, requests, demands or other communications hereunder shall be in writing, and shall be deemed to have been duly given if delivered in person, or within 3 days after deposited in the mail, postage prepaid, certified, with return receipt requested, or otherwise actually delivered to Owners at

PARTIES BOUND; ASSIGNMENT

This agreement shall be binding on and inure to the benefit of the successors and assigns of the parties hereto, and their respective successors and assigns; provided, however, that this agreement may not be assigned by Agent without prior written consent of Owners, or by Owners without prior written consent of Agent. Anything in the foregoing to the contrary notwithstanding, Agent may, without the consent of Owners, delegate the performance of (but not responsibility for) any duties and obligations of Agent to any independent contractor or entity.

GOVERNING LAW

This agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of Maldives.

MODIFICATION

This agreement may not be modified unless such modification is in writing and signed by both parties to this agreement.

Taxation

The Tenant shall be liable for all taxes levied against any leasehold interest of the Tenant or personal property and trade fixtures owned or placed by the Tenant in the Leased Premises.

Taxation due to Maldives Inland Revenue (MIRA) can be processed by PRE, a one off charge of MRF 1500/- shall be charged at taxation period. All financials and legalities shall be presented to MIRA by Pan Real Estate.

TENANCY AGREEMENT

Between

TENANT

And

PAN REAL ESTATE PRIVATE LIMITED

Beginning of term: **4th June 2014**

Ending of term: **4th June 2015**

In the event where the Tenant wishes to renew the Agreement upon or before expiry, the Tenant shall give a written Notice to the Agent prior to **Two (2)** months of expiry of this Agreement. The Clause 4.2 & 4.3 is not applicable or followed since the Agreement is a renewable.

RENT, SECURITY DEPOSIT AND ADVANCE RENT

4.1 Rent:

The Tenant agrees to pay the Agent and the Agent agrees to accept, during the term hereof, monthly rent for the entire term of the Lease in the amount of **USD 1500 (United States Dollars One Thousand Five Hundred ONLY)** payable before the 5th of each month. The rent shall not be altered during the term of this Agreement.

The Rent shall be paid by the Tenant to the Agent either by depositing to the following bank account nominated by the Agent before the 5th day of each calendar month, except only if the term of this Agreement does not begin on the beginning of a calendar month.

4.2 Security Deposit:

The Tenant shall pay an amount equivalent to **TWO (2)** month's rent at the time of signing this agreement to the Agent. This security deposit shall remain with the Agent throughout the term of this Agreement. This security deposit will be returned to the Tenant by the Agent after expenses for maintenance and repairs, unpaid utility bills are settled for the Leased Premises upon or before the expiry of the Agreement.

4.3 Advance Rent:

The Tenant shall pay **ONE (1)** month's advance rent to the Agent upon signing this Agreement. For the avoidance of doubt, the **ONE (1)** Months advance rent shall be considered as the rent for the first **ONE (1)** months of the term of this Agreement and the rent for the third month shall be paid before the 5th day of third month in accordance with clause 4.1 and 4.2 of this Agreement.

4.4 Commencement of Rental Payment:

For the avoidance of doubt, the Tenant shall commence payment before the 5th day of **July 2014**.

AGENT'S REMEDIES

In the event that Tenant shall on two or more occasions be in default in the payment of rent required to be paid by Tenant (default herein being defined as payment not received by the Agent five or more days subsequent to the due date, which is the 5th day of the calendar month), regardless of whether or not such default has occurred on consecutive or non-consecutive months, then Landlord acting through the Agent shall be entitled to its election (unless Tenant shall cure such default prior to such election), to terminate this Agreement by giving the Tenant **SIXTY (60)** days' notice of termination, in which event this Agreement shall expire and terminate on the date specified in such notice of termination, with the same force and effect as though the date so specified were the date herein originally fixed as the termination date of the term of this lease, and all rights of Tenant under this Agreement and in and to the Leased Premises shall expire and terminate, and Tenant shall remain liable for all obligations under this Agreement arising up to the date of such termination, and Tenant shall surrender the Leased Premises to Landlord or to the Agent on the date specified in such notice.

USE OF LEASED PREMISES BY TENANT

The Leased Premises may be occupied and used by Tenant exclusively for **Residential** purposes. Nothing herein shall give Tenant the right to use the property for any other purpose.

The Tenants must also abide by the following:

Tenants must not use the balcony railings for hanging clothes out to dry.

Occupancy of the Leased premises must not exceed the agreed limit agreed by both parties.

If pets are involved, then it must be notified during the contract signing.

If Tenants decides to make any changes to the interior (drilling holes, etc...), the Agent must be notified as it is stated in the Clause 12.4

WASTE, NUISANCE, OR UNLAWFUL ACTIVITY

Tenant shall not allow any waste or nuisance on the Leased Premises, or use or allow the Leased Premises to be used for any unlawful purpose.

RESPECT FOR OTHERS.

Anti-social behavior. The tenant, those living with the tenant and visitors to the Leased Premises must not harass, or act in an anti-social manner to, any person in the neighborhood on any ground, including that person's racial or ethnic origin, color, religion, sex, gender, sexual orientation, age, disability or other status.

Anti-social means causing, or likely to cause, alarm, distress, nuisance or annoyance to any person or causing damage to anyone's property. Harassment of a person includes causing the person alarm or distress.

QUIET ENJOYMENT

Landlord covenants and agrees that upon Tenant paying the rent and observing and performing all of the terms, covenants and conditions on Tenant's part to be observed and performed hereunder, that Tenant may peaceably and quietly have, hold, occupy and enjoy the Leased Premises in accordance with the terms of this Lease without hindrance or molestation from Landlord or Agent any persons lawfully claiming through Landlord.

TAXES

The Tenant shall be liable for any taxes levied against any leasehold interest of the Tenant or personal property placed by the Tenant in the Leased Premises. In the event any taxes are imposed on the Leased Premises affecting the net rental amount received by the Agent, the Agent shall have the right to impose such increments to the Tenant.

UTILITIES

Tenant shall pay for water, sanitation, electricity, janitorial, telephone, cable television and other services incident to Tenant's use of the Leased Premises.

OBLIGATIONS FOR REPAIRS

Agent's Repairs:

12.1 Subject to any provisions herein to the contrary, and except for maintenance or replacement necessitated as the result of the act or omission of the Tenant, the Agent shall be required to repair only defects, deficiencies, deviations or failures of materials or workmanship in the building of the Leased Premises.

The structure and outside of the property;

The exterior paintwork of the property;

Installation for supply of the gas, water, electric and water and water-heating;

Appliances for making use of the supply of water, gas, electricity or other sources of the heating;

Installations for sanitation (for example sinks, bath, shower, toilets);
Installations for the detection of smoke, fire, carbon dioxide and intruder.

12.2 The Agent's obligation to repair, maintain and decorate must be construed subject to the following:

The Agent is not under any duty to repair or maintain anything which is a Tenant responsibility or to carry out any works for which the tenant is liable by virtue of this Agreement or otherwise.

The Agent is not under any duty to repair or maintain anything:

Which was not constructed or provided by the Agent, or any person from whom the Agent derived title, or any previous Tenant (other than anything which was consent of the Agent has been given); or

Which the Tenant is entitled to remove from the dwelling.

In determining the standard of repair or maintenance necessary for compliance with the Agent's obligations, regard is to be had to age, character and prospective life of the dwelling at the time of the need for the relevant repair or maintenance.

The Agent is not under any duty to carry out any work by virtue of its obligations to repair or maintain until a reasonable period has elapsed after the Agent has been given written and specific notice (by or behalf of the Tenant) of the need for such work.

Tenant's Repairs:

12.3 The Tenant shall repair and maintain the Leased Premises in good order and condition, except for reasonable wear and tear, the repairs required of Agent pursuant hereto under 11(a). The tenant is responsible for repair (including replacement) of damage to the Leased Premises or loss of any of the fixtures, fittings and items in the inventory, caused through the fault of the Tenant's household or visitors of the Tenants. For the avoidance of doubt the tenant must bear the cost of clearing blocked drains caused by dirty gully traps, or clearing waste pipes inside individual dwelling where the obstruction has been caused by misuse.

12.4 The tenant is not entitled without the prior written permission of the Agent to:

Alter, improve or enlarge the accommodation;

Add new fixtures or fitting to the accommodation

Install external satellite aerials or dishes;

Erect any type of sign, flag or advertisement visible from outside the accommodation

Erect a shed, garage or other structure at the accommodation

Decorate the outside of the accommodation

12.5 The Tenant is responsible for taking reasonable care of the Leased Premises. This includes carrying out minor routine maintenance, replacement of appliances and internal decoration. The Tenant must keep the Leased Premises in a reasonable state of cleanliness and decoration.

RIGHT TO ENTRY

The Agent has the right to enter the accommodation for carrying out repairs or maintenance to the accommodation or the utilities serving or, at reasonable time during the day 48 hours' prior written notice.

13.1 The Agent will, in conjunction with other co-owner, take reasonable steps to keep the common parts in repair and fit for use by the tenant.

13.2 The Agent shall return to the Tenant any rent payable in respect of any period during which the property may have been rendered uninhabitable.

13.3 If repairs are delayed due to failure by the Tenant to grant access to the Agent's repairmen, the cost of damages caused as a result of such delays shall be borne by the Tenant.

DUTY TO REPORT

The Tenant must report any damage to the accommodation, or the common parts, or the need for repairs or maintenance, as soon as reasonable practicable. The Tenant must immediately report to the Agent any emergencies affecting the accommodation including interruption to the supply of water and electricity.

Tenant should inform the Agent by email or any other written form as soon as the damage has been identified. In situations where the issues needs to solved with urgency such, water pipe leakage, gas leaks and electrical failures and urgencies which may evolve to dangerous outcomes, the Tenant shall inform via the numbers specified by the Agent;

The Agent is required to respond to such urgencies in a prompt manner and undertake to resolve such issues at the earliest.

In situations where the Tenant does not inform the Agent on such urgencies, the Agent will not be liable for any loss resulting from such incidents and the Tenant shall be liable for such damages.

ILLEGAL CONDUCT

If the Tenant or people authorized by the Tenant does or cause to be done, any act in violation of any laws of the Maldives, the Agent will inform the relevant government authorities and the Agent shall the right to terminate this Agreement.

TERMINATION

The Tenant may terminate this agreement prior to the termination of the duration of this agreement subject to complying with the following:

- 16.1 by giving **SIXTY (60)** days advance notice to the Agent in writing;
- 16.2 the leased premises shall be in good condition. In the event of any damage to any fixtures or if the interior paint has been removed or any other damage has been caused, the Tenant shall rectify these, or shall make payments to the Agent for the costs association with the said rectification;
- 16.3 all utility bills shall be settled by the Agent prior to termination of the agreement.

17. WAIVERS AND NOTICES

Waivers:

Failure of either party to complain of any act or omission on the part of the other party, no matter how long the same may continue, shall not be deemed to be a waiver by said party of any of its rights hereunder. No waiver by either party at any time, express or implied, of any breach of any provision of this Agreement shall be deemed a waiver of a breach of any other provision of this Agreement or a consent to any subsequent breach of the same or any other provision. If any action by either party shall require the consent or approval of the other party, the other party's consent to or approval of such action on any one occasion shall not be deemed a consent to or approval of said action on any subsequent occasion or a consent to or approval of any other action on the same or any subsequent occasion. Any and all rights and remedies which either party may have under this Agreement or by operation of law, either at law or upon any breach, shall be distinct, separate and cumulative and shall not be deemed inconsistent with each other, and no one of them, whether exercised by said party or not, shall be deemed to be an exclusion of any other; and any two or more or all of such rights and remedies may be exercised at the same time.

Notices:

All notices and other communications authorized or required hereunder shall be in writing and shall be given by mailing the same by certified mail, or delivered by hand in which case return receipt shall be requested, and any such notice or other communication shall be deemed to have been given when received by the party to whom such notice or other communication shall be addressed.

18. LOSS AND DAMAGE

Notwithstanding any contrary provisions of this Agreement, the Landlord or the Agent shall not be responsible for any loss of or damage to property of Tenant or of others located on the Leased Premises, except where caused by the willful act or omission or negligence the Agent, or employees or contractors.

19. FORCE MAJEURE

In the event that Landlord or Tenant shall be delayed or hindered in or prevented from the performance of any act, by reason of strikes, lockouts, war or civil unrest, riots, insurrections, an act, failure to act, or default of the other party, war or other reason beyond its control, then performance of such act shall be excused for the period of the delay and the period for the performance of such act shall be extended for a period equivalent to the period of such delay. Notwithstanding the foregoing, lack of funds shall not be deemed to be a cause beyond control of either party.

20. ASSIGNMENT AND SUBLETTING

Under the terms and conditions hereunder, Tenant shall not have the right to transfer and assign this Agreement or to sublet all or any portion of the Leased Premises.

21. FIXTURES

All personal property, furnishings and equipment presently and all other trade fixtures installed in or hereafter by or at the expense of Tenant and all additions and/or improvements, exclusive of structural, mechanical, electrical, and plumbing, affixed to the Leased Premises and used by the Tenant, in or on the Leased Premises by and at the expense of Tenant and susceptible of being removed from the Leased Premises without damage, unless such damage be repaired by Tenant, shall remain the property of Tenant and Tenant may, but shall not be obligated to, remove the same or any part thereof at any time or times during the term hereof, provided that Tenant, at its sole cost and expense, shall make any repairs occasioned by such removal.

22. INVALIDITY OF PARTICULAR PROVISION

If any term or provision of this Lease or the application hereof to any person or circumstance shall, to any extent, be held invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this Lease, or the application of such term or provision to persons or circumstances other than those as to which it is held invalid or unenforceable, shall not be affected thereby, and each term and provision of this Lease shall be valid and be enforced to the fullest extent permitted by law.

23. RELATIONSHIP OF THE PARTIES

Nothing contained herein shall be deemed or construed by the parties hereto nor by any third party as creating the relationship of principal and agent or of partnership or of a joint venture between the parties hereto, it being understood and agreed that neither any provision contained herein, nor any acts of the parties hereto, shall be deemed to create any relationship between the parties hereto other than the relationship of Agent and Tenant.

24. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This instrument contains the entire and only agreement between the parties, and no oral statements or representations or prior written matter not contained in this instrument shall have any force and effect. This Lease shall not be modified in any way except by a writing executed by both parties.

25. GOVERNING LAW

All matters pertaining to this agreement (including its interpretation, application, validity, performance and breach) shall be governed by, construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the Republic of Maldives.

26. MODIFICATION

This agreement may not be modified unless such modification is in writing and signed by both parties to this agreement.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have executed this Agreement as of the date first above written.

Whereas the Seller wishes to market the units in the real property ("Units");
whereas the Agent is prepared to sell the Units on behalf of the Seller in return for a commission;
It is agreed as follows:

1. SELLING RIGHTS

a. The Seller grants the Agent an exclusive right to sell the Units on behalf of the Seller for a period of 03 (THREE) months commencing on the 01st of FEBRUARY 2015 to 30th of APRIL 2015 ("Selling Rights").

b. The Agent may not sell or attempt to sell the Units outside of the terms described in this Agreement.

c. The Agent shall use his best efforts to sell the Units for the duration of the Selling Rights. At the request from time to time of the Seller, the Agent shall furnish the Seller with a reasonably detailed, written report on his efforts to sell the Units in the period specified by the Seller.

d. The Agent shall clearly identify himself as a duly authorized sales agent of the Seller in the course of his efforts to sell the Units on behalf of the Seller and may not sell the Units in his own name.

2. PRODUCT PRICES

The Seller shall fix the selling price(s) of the Units and the Agent may only sell the Units at the selling price(s) fixed by the Seller.

3. ORDERS

a. The Agent shall obtain written orders for the Units from buyers, signed by or on behalf of the buyers, and remit the orders to the Seller.

b. The Seller shall use its best efforts to fill orders duly remitted by the Agent in accordance with this agreement as expeditiously as possible.

4. COMMISSION

a. The Seller shall pay the Agent a commission of 5% of the sales price, exclusive of any sales taxes, of each order or part of each order of Units duly remitted by the Agent in accordance with this agreement which is paid for in full, inclusive of any sales taxes, and which is not subsequently returned for a refund.

b. The Seller may accept the return of Units for a refund or partial refund in its sole discretion.

c. The Agent is not entitled to any compensation for services performed or expenses incurred in connection with this agreement other than as set out in this agreement.

The Agent shall not do or permit anything to be done to prejudice the market image of the Units or the Seller.

7. RESTRAINT OF COMPETITION

8. CONFIDENTIALITY
