IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

STUDENT VOICE: Any student interested in being on the Student Voice Team should the <u>Google Form linked here</u> for consideration. If you were on the team last year, you are eligible to be on the team again this year, but you must still complete the form below to be considered.

HOME ACCESS CENTER: HAC forms will be sent home with students on Monday. This information will allow you to access your child's grade online.

CELL PHONES: We have had many cell phones taken up recently. Below are the consequences for not following the electronic device policy at HHS:

PENALTY FOR THE MISUSE OF AN ELECTRONIC DEVICE IS AS FOLLOWS:

Students who fail to follow the guidelines for the use of electronic devices will have their device confiscated by the teacher/staff member and delivered to the administrator. The device may be picked up in the school office by a parent or guardian on the day the device

is confiscated between 3:00-3:30 PM or any following school day between 7:30 AM-3:30 PM. On the first and second offenses, the student will be given a warning in addition to the confiscation of the electronic device. If a student's electronic device is confiscated three (3) times, the student will receive two (2) days of detention. On the fourth (4) offense, the student will receive one (1) day of ISS. If the student has an electronic device confiscated five (5) or more times, the student will receive three (3) days of ISS.

Notice that the policy only allows for a parent or guardian to pick up the electronic device. Parents, please refrain from being angry with the high school secretary when this information is relayed to you. She is simply doing her job, and we must follow the handbook as written! I ask that you remind your child to keep their electronic device in their backpacks in order to avoid it being taken.
