









SERRA DA CAPIVARA

National Park

Besides of being one of the greatest research centers, that tracks the history of the American man, The National Park of Serra da Capivara, is located in-between two endemic and unique Brazilian ecosystems: The Cerrado and The Caatinga - The strong aridity of this region and its exotic species, makes the ''Sertões'' a place Worth visiting. The thousands of rock paintings with very good quality, in the region helped to study the human currents in America and the creation of a fantastic museum — The Museum of American Men.

SCPKG#01 = 4 Days & 03 Nights: SERRA DA CAPIVARA NATIONAL PARK & MUSEUM OF AMERICAN MAN

Pick-up/Drop-off: PETROLINA-PE – Every day with minimum 2 people. (private services)

1st DAY: PETROLINA - Arrival at Airport and transfer by private car to the hotel Quality Petrolina or similar – Petrolina is the capital of a rich region, that has the great Rio São Francisco (San Francisco River – 2830Kms of extension) as the main economic source, like: Hydroelectric plants; the great center of Fruits exportation and cattle raising.

Enjoy the city and at night do not miss a visit to the 'Bododromo' – a gastronomic center with live Forró music and exotic culinary from the 'Sertões'.

Rest of day and night at leisure. Overnight with Brazilian Breakfast.

2nd day: PETROLINA/SÃO RAIMUNDO NONATO - Early morning leave the hotel by private car along the board of the Old Chico – São Francisco River, passing by rustic villages until arrive (5 hours' drive) to São Raimundo Nonato –

Gateway to the National Park and Museum of American Man. After a short relax and lunch (not included) depart for a visit to the Museum of The American Man and then drive to the canyon of Capivara to explore the most important Archaeological sites of the park. Overnight with breakfast.

3rd Day: SÃO RAIMUNDO NONATO – Breakfast and leave for a full day exploring the circuit Jurubeba: with trails in the Caatinga ecossystem, where you will learn about the environment, culture of the American Man and the actual "Nordestinos" or "Sertanejos" - brave people that survives in the drylands. Lunch included at Móco Farm and end of afternoon drive to the Serra Branca (White range) to



watch one of the best sunsets in Brazil, with the amazing uproar made by thousands of swallow's birds. Return to hotel. Overnight with Breakfast.





Breakfast included.



4th Day – **SÃO RAIMUNDO NONATO / PETROLINA** – Transfer - departure time will depend on the departure of Your flight in Petrolina. Transfer to Airport in Petrolina (4-5 hours). End of our services....

Including: All transfers, Tours, lunch at Mocó farm, services in private way with English or French speaking guide (*) and Accommodation in Standard rooms with tax and breakfast. (*) booking should be made in advance, in order to guarantee bi-lingual guide.

Not including: Meals not mentioned, drinks, travel insurance or flights.

SCPKG#02 = 5 DAYS & 04 NIGHTS: The Sertões BAHIA/PERNAMBUCO DRYLANDS & SERRA DA CAPIVARA:

Pick-up: Salvador or Lençois (Chapada Diamantina)/ Drop-off: PETROLINA-PE Airport. Every day with minimum 2 people. (private services)

1st Day: MONTE SANTO-BA: Pick-up early morning at Your hotel in Salvador or Lençois (Chapada Diamantina), by private car and guide for a drive, around 4-5 hours, with stops at the mining route and visiting on the way, rustic villages of the Drylands, until reach the village of Monte Santo – lunch on route (included). This village is known as the mystic heart of Sertões, because of its primitive catholic tradition. Afternoon, we will walk up the Via Crucis for a whole view of the region and the tiny but interesting Museum of Sertões. Overnight at Hotel Moura or similar.

2nd Day: MONTE SANTO / PETROLINA: Depart after breakfast by a traditional Route of Sertões, that cross a vast area of drylands and is the nesting place of hundreds of birds, including the beautiful Ararinha-azul (Cyanopsitta Spixii) that is considered in extinction, but was seen on this route a few times. Lunch in route (included). Arrival to Petrolina and short visit to the Irrigation project for fruit and wine production. Accommodation at Hotel Quality Petrolina or similar. Night at leisure: do not miss a visit to the 'Bododromo' – a gastronomic center with live Forró music and exotic culinary from the 'Sertões'. Overnight with breakfast.

3rd Day = PETROLINA/SÃO RAIMUNDO NONATO: Early morning leave the hotel by private car along the board of the



Old Chico – São Francisco River, passing by rustic villages until arrive (4/5 hours' drive) to São Raimundo Nonato – Gateway to the National Park and Museum of American Man. After a short relax and lunch (not included) depart for a visit to the Museum of The American Man and then drive to the canyon of Capivara to explore the most important Archaeological sites of the park. Night at leisure and overnight with breakfast.

4th day: SÃO RAIMUNDO NONATO - Breakfast and leave for a full day exploring the circuit Jurubeba: with trails in the Caatinga







ecosystem, where you will learn about the environment, culture of the American Man and the actual "Nordestinos" or "Sertanejos" - brave people that survives in the drylands.
