Written in font palatino linotype, size 10pt, italic, align justify

Keywords: consist of 3-5 words and delimited by a semicolon (;)

INTRODUCTION

This introduction contains the reasons why the author chooses the topic to be discussed by suggesting a knowledge gap and offering a school of thought that differentiates it from other writers, besides that it also includes a literature review, emphasizing the novelty that the author will find, exposure to gaps and arguments from the author in closing the gap. This introduction is written in 2 - 5 paragraphs (800-1000 words). Written in MS. Word (.doc/.docx/.rtf) with the font Palatino Linotype, size 11pt, align justify, spacing-after 6pt, and line spacing-single, paper size A4, margin top 3 cm, left 4 cm, right 3 cm, bottom 3 cm, different checklists odd and even, and from the 1.7 edge-header and footer 0.7. The space for article is 1 space.

Moreover, the author(s) are required to use this template (NOT creating new file) in order to avoid unsuitable matches in the whole page layouts (margins, paper sizes, etc.). The subtitles must be written in the uppercase or capital letter. At the end of this section, the research should state the purpose of this research.

RESEARCH METHODS

The method contains the identification of research variables, research instruments, and method uses statistical analysis techniques. Written in a concise and detailed manner which contain information that can be replicated. Written in 1 - 2 paragraphs (150 - 300 words). Written in Palatino Linotype, size 11pt, single Line Spacing.

RESEARCH RESULTS and DISCUSSION

The results of the study contain clean data (not process/results that are still being processed), hypothesis testing, answering research questions and research findings. The discussion is directed at interpreting the results, comparing the results with other studies and their implications with research results.

It is an affirmation of the data coverage of an article and is used as the basis for analysis, in addition to the results as confirmation of the novelty of the article. Results and discussions written in 3-5 sub-topics, with each sub-topic containing 2,500 - 3,000 words containing First Sub Topic, Second Sub Topic, Third Sub Topic.

The First Sub Topic

Sub topics written in bold and capitalizing each word. The Findings are description of results, and it can be completed with chart(s) / graphic(s) / diagram(s) / table(s). All must be written in manuscript in order to make it easier for reviewers to see the meaning of the table. An example of naming graphics / images can be seen below:

The conclusions are written based on the research results. Conclusions are written in concise manner, in the form of paragraphs consisting 1-2 paragraphs (300-500 words). Conclusions also consist of the advantages and disadvantages of the research findings and the possibilities for expanding the study.

Footnote

Footnote should be placed at the foot of the relevant page. Footnote using a reference application such as Zotero (APA Manual of Style 17th edition - full note). Written in Palatino Linotype, size 9pt, single Line Spacing.

BIBLIOGRAPHY

For bibliographic format and style, it refers to Zotero's reference system (APA manual of style 17th edition-full note).
