Updated Guidelines from the MA Dept of Public Health

The Massachusetts Department of Public Health has updated its guidelines for Covid-19 and other respiratory viruses. Please review the updates here.

Some important points to remember:

- If your child is not feeling well, please keep them home.
- If your child develops a fever, they should not return to school until they have been fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication such as Tylenol, Advil, etc.
- If your child has tested positive for Covid-19 or another respiratory virus, and is not symptomatic, it is recommended that they stay home for 72 hours to help reduce the chance of spreading the virus to others.

Total Solar Eclipse Education And Fun!

- Although the solar eclipse on April 8, 2024 will not be total in Westford, it will be close with a magnitude of 94% totality!
- Families may wish to use this simulator to see what the eclipse will look like in Westford, Massachusetts or to see the eclipse simulated in other cities!
- All Westford students will be given a certified pair of eclipse glasses to take home and use during the eclipse. It is imperative that no one look directly at the sun (without certified protection) during any part of the eclipse in Westford, as looking at the sun can cause permanent eye damage.
