For next year: mentioned that there is interest in other fundraisers, but Anne strongly encourages us to sign a contract for next year's run and research other/new options for the following year. Anne asked the representative from Boosterthon if they would lower the percentage that they take? They cannot but did provide a breakdown of what the company takes (their share) and

different service levels available at different percentages; see attached. For 2024 MES raised \$67,592 so our split percentage was 44/57 this year (MES kept 57% of the total amount raised this year). Consensus is to keep the Run for 2024-2025.
