David Yancey (R-94)

Has voted for bills that would have:

Harmed Public Education

 created an unconstitutional school board agency, outside local school board jurisdiction. HB 1400

Limited Access to Healthcare

- blocked Medicaid Expansion. HB 1500 PASSED
- dismantled Virginia's compliance with the Affordable Care Act, even though it improved access to healthcare for thousands of Virginians. HB2411

Opposed Living Wages and Employee Benefits

- prohibited state government from requiring contractors to pay employees at prevailing wages. <u>HB1596</u>
- restricted local governments from making decisions about the wages contractors pay employees. <u>HB1753</u>
- relieved franchisors from an employer's obligations to employees, which can shift the burden onto small, Virginia-based franchisees. HB1394

Denied Voting Access to Eligible Voters

- disenfranchised eligible voters by requiring photo ID even for absentee ballots. HB 1428
- denied voter registration to people who failed to indicate their date of birth twice on an application. <u>HB9 (2016)</u>. Taking away the vote over a technicality.
- closed voter registration at 5 PM instead of midnight on the last day of voter registration before an election. <u>SB1303</u>. Making voting harder for workers.

Obstructed Clean Air and Clean Water; Sent Taxpayer Funds to Special Interests

- reinstated the costly, ineffective Coal Tax Credit. <u>HB2198</u>
- thrown up roadblocks to the national Clean Power Plan, damaging our environment. <u>HB2 (2016)</u>

Discriminated and Unconstitutionally Overruled Local Communities

- taken away local governments' authority to remove Civil War memorials. <u>HB587 (2016)</u>
- allowed discrimination against gay and lesbian couples. <u>HB 2025</u>

Endangered Legal Immigrants and Driven Away Job Creators

- prohibited state or local officials from releasing people suspected of violating immigration laws. Unnecessary and anti-immigrant. <u>HB1468</u>
- prohibited Virginia towns from becoming sanctuary cities, even though none are. This would sow discord and drive job creators away. HB2000
- publicly revealed the personal info of legal refugees fleeing persecution. This would pose a real danger to new, thoroughly vetted, legal Virginians. <u>HB2002</u>

Denied Women and Families Healthcare Access and Autonomy

- chose not to vote on bill to defunded Planned Parenthood. <u>HB2264</u>
- abstained on bill that called Roe v. Wade's anniversary a "Day of Tears" in Virginia and encouraged Virginians to lower their flags to half-staff. This passed! <u>HR268</u>

Decreased Gun Safety

- allowed members of armed services to carry a concealed handgun off duty, even if they had been disqualified from access to weapons. HB1582
- let school security officers carry guns even if their training was years ago or didn't cover the use of force around juveniles. <u>HB1234 (2016)</u>
- restricted some agencies' ability to regulate firearms even for safety in public buildings. HB1096 (2016)
