High School Applicants (May 2026 high school graduates) for CTE 10: 1 Scholarship:

We hope this message finds you well. As you anticipate your first year of college, we want to inform you about a scholarship opportunity.

CTE 10 is a partnership of thirty-six school districts in Western Wisconsin. All of the participating districts are in a ten-county region that includes Buffalo, Chippewa, Clark, Dunn, Eau Claire, Jackson, Pepin, Rusk, Taylor, and Trempealeau. For a full list of member schools, click [here](#).

CTE 10 is offering \$2,000 scholarships to high school seniors (May 2026 grads) who plan to major in Career and Technical Education. This includes Agricultural Education, Business and Marketing Education, Family and Consumer Science Education, and Technology Education.

Students who are awarded these scholarships will receive \$2000 in the Spring semester upon submission of their first-semester college grades and course schedules for the Spring 2027 semester.

How do you apply?

1. Review the CTE 10:1 [Working Application](#). Answer the questions in this Word document. This will allow you to have a draft before submitting the Application Form.
2. Review the CTE 10:1 [Evaluation Rubric](#); this is how your application will be evaluated.
3. Use this [link](#) to complete and submit your application (form opens 2/2/26).
4. Applications are due by midnight on **March 2, 2026**.

When will I know if I am awarded a Scholarship?

1. Notification of awards will occur the week of April 6, 2026. All applicants will be notified of their standing, whether they are awarded a scholarship or not.
2. Upon receipt of the award, candidates agree to send their transcripts at the completion of the Fall 2026 semester. Funds will be disbursed to the Bursar on your campus after your grades and a copy of your spring semester schedule are received.
