How would you translate the following:

10. *** We just finished cleaning the family room but still have to clean the bathrooms. (=>acabar + de + infinitive means to just acabar is regular)

11. *** My brother wants to help with the chores but he doesn't cook very well. He prefers to set the table (=>Preferir + infinitive means to prefer to)

12. *** Before celebrating, one must clean the house because it is dirty. (=>hay + que + infinitive)

13. Carmen is going to give a party because it is Roberto's birthday but it is a surprise.

14. Carla, Ana, Roberto y yo want to go to the party but we are not able to go because we have to study.
