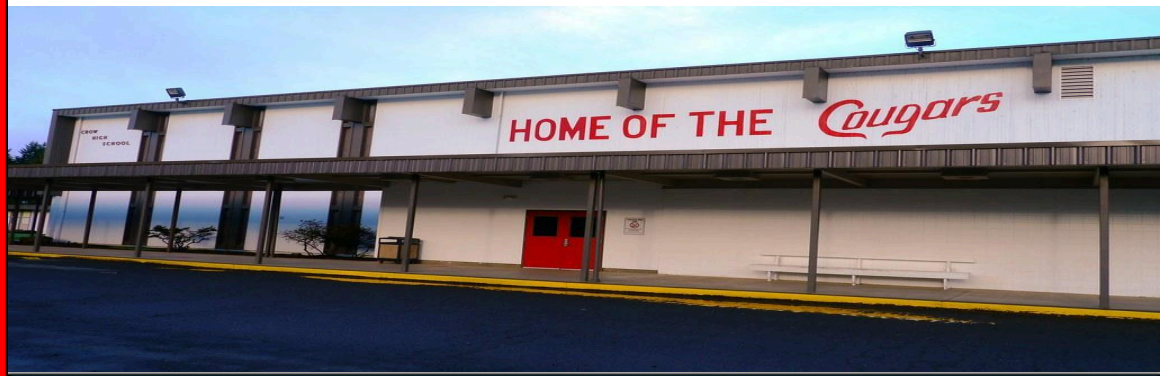


# Student Shout Outs!
