Honors Composition Courses

The Berkshire Honors Scholar Composition Sequence provides an alternative to BCC's traditional composition sequence by offering two courses that challenge you in rigorous academic writing, research, and presentation methods.

<u>ENG 103 Honors Composition I</u> can be taken instead of ENG 101, providing practice in formulating written arguments, conducting college-level research, and reading critically through a variety of lenses.

<u>ENG 104 Honors Composition II</u> can be taken instead of ENG 102, and is a research and presentation methods course during which you will undertake individually developed research projects and learn how to present them in a variety of academic formats. For students who want to work in the Writing Center as tutors, but also earn honors credit for Comp II, there is also the option to take **ENG 235H Honors Advanced Composition & Training for Writing Tutors**

You do *not* need to take both of the Honors Composition courses. For example, you can take ENG 101 and then ENG 104.
