

UNIVERSITY OF CEBU CHORUS PROFILE

The UC Chorus is the official choral group of the University of Cebu. Promoting Cebuano and Philippine culture through music is the primary goal of the group as the singing ambassadors of the University of Cebu, offering a diverse and captivating repertoire from classical to contemporary choral music that showcases vocal and dance skills according to the genre and rhythm of the songs. Established in 1980, the group was known for their glee-type singing technique. In 2018, the group shifted from glee to classical and choral pop singing with the guidance of the current choir director, Mr. Julyone G. Sacay.

Significant milestones:

- The group has participated and performed in various concerts for cause.
- In 2019, the group bagged a silver medal in the sacred category on their first ever international choir competition, Cantata Macau 2019, held in Macau, China.
- In 2023, the group participated and was able to virtually perform in the Empowerment and Development for University Choirs (EDUC) program spearheaded by the Philippine Madrigal Singers in partnership with the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA).
- In 2024, the group became a finalist in the L. Kerschbamer Competition, landing 4th place among the 5 finalists, showcasing their growth and potential in local competitions.
