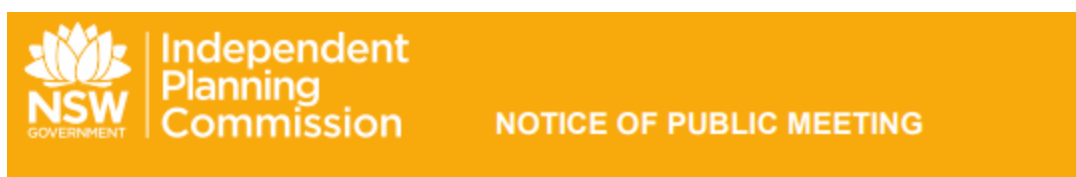

Eastern Creek Energy from Waste Facility SSD 6236

I am writing to you as you've previously provided comment or made a submission to the NSW Department of Planning and Environment on the above development application.

The Department has now completed its assessment of the proposal and referred it to the Independent Planning Commission for determination. The State's planning laws designate the Commission as the consent authority for this proposal, as 25 or more submissions by way of an objection were received by the Department, Council has made an objection and a political disclosure statement has been made.

The Commission Members appointed to determine the proposal are Ms Robyn Kruk AM (Chair), Mr Peter Duncan AM, and Mr Tony Pearson.

Because of the considerable interest in this proposal, we'll be meeting to listen to the community's views on the Department's assessment report. This is your last chance to have your say before our independent experts make their decision.

The meeting will take place at **11:00am on Monday, 14 May 2018 at Rooty Hill RSL, 55 Sherbrooke Street Rooty Hill NSW 2766.**

If you wish to apply to speak at the meeting, you must register your interest by completing the attached form (also available online) and returning it via email to ipcn@ipcn.nsw.gov.au before **5:00pm on Tuesday 8 May 2018.**

Because we know some people find public speaking trying, and there will be others who cannot attend on the day, we will accept written comments up to one week after the public meeting. Written comments are weighed the same as spoken presentations.

From 1 March 2018, the Commission is required to record its public meetings and publish the audio recording or written transcript of the public meetings on its website. This meeting will be audio recorded, with a written transcript published on the Commission's website. Personal information will be managed in accordance with the Commission's Privacy Statement.
