Details

Main Event—Hybrid Best Game Qualifying + Head-to-Head Finals

Qualifying: Hybrid best game qualifying runs for 21 hours.

- Thursday, August 13th (2pm-9pm)
- Friday, August 14th (2pm-9pm)
- Saturday, August 15th (2pm-9pm).

Players can join queues online (at matchplay.events) or in-person with an official scorekeeper. A player's best 12 scores on 8 games (max 2 per game) will be counted using PAPA 200 scoring (200/190/185/184...).

Attempts: All players will be limited to 32 entries maximum. Players must play at least 6 games to be included in results and finals consideration.

Pricing:

- \$5 for registration (includes 12 entries)
- \$10 for additional 10 entries
- \$10 for additional 10 entries

Players are not required to purchase beyond the \$5 entrance fee (12 entries), but will be able to drop lowest scores if more entries are purchased.

Finals: The Top 24 compete in head-to-head, best of 5 games/round, top 8 get byes. Finals start Sunday, August 16th at 12:00pm.

Juniors Division: Players under 18 can visit the registration desk during qualifying to request to be included in this division. The Top 2 at the end of qualifying win trophies without affecting main tournament results. Juniors Division is restricted to players who are not ranked in the IFPA Top 1000.

Game Bank: The qualifying game bank will be 8 arenas TBA. Finals will be an expanded 12 arenas TBA.

Registration: Register in person at the event. With 48+ players, we expect this to be an IFPA Certified event, boosting TGP to 250%!

Prize Pool: All entry fee money in this tournament goes towards cash prizes for the top 16 (less \$1 for IFPA fee). In a \$1500 pool example (80 players with an average entry spend of \$18.75 per player):

- 1st (30%) = \$450
- 2nd (18%) = \$270
- 3rd (12%) = \$180
- 4th (8%) = \$120
- 5th-8th (4%) = \$60 each
- 9th-16th (2%) = \$30 each

Additional Information: All coin drops on the Main event machines will be donated to Project Pinball. Triangle Pinball Collective will separately donate \$5 to Project Pinball for every entrant to this event. The Bradley family has generously volunteered to match this \$5/person donation. Results for this tournament will also be submitted to Punk Rock Pinball Association (PRPA)

Side Tournament—Pace Matchplay

Date: Thursday, August 13th, 7pm

Format: Pace Matchplay, 5 Round Minimum

Pricing: \$10, First \$1 to IFPA then \$9 to Project Pinball. Results will also be submitted to PRPA.

Bank: Machines outside of Main Event bank and High Score Competition.

Women's Tournament—5 Strike Fair Knockout

Date: Friday, Aug 14th, 7pm

Format: 5 Strike Fair Knockout, 0/1/1/2, 0/1/2.

Cost: \$5, First \$1 to IFPA then \$4 to Project Pinball. Results will also be submitted to PRPA

Machines: Machines outside of Main Event bank and High Score Competition.

Prizes: Donations from Local Businesses and Triangle Pinball Collective

High Score Challenge

Date: Thursday August 13th—Saturday August 15th)

Format: High Score on one machine, tracked through Insider Connected, with unlimited entries.

Cost: Coin drop on machine (All coin drops will be donated to Project Pinball).
