- Card Stock and Paper: Thick Basic White (159229); Basic White (159276); Basic Gray (121044); Smoky Slate (131202); Country Woods 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper(163393)
- Stamp Pads: Misty Moonlight (153118)
- **Tools:** Frosted Forest Dies (164136); Stapler
- Miscellaneous: Pecan Pie & Clear Ribboned Adhesive-Backed Dots (164204); Stampin' Seal Adhesive (152813); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755)



Measurements:

Thick Basic White: 4 ¼" x 11"
Basic White: 5" x 3 ¾"; 5" x 3 ½"
Basic Gray: 4" x 5 ¼" (x2)
Smoky Slate: ¾" x 1 ½"

DSP: 5" x 3 ¾"

Instructions:

- 1. Score Thick Basic White at 5 ½" and create card base.
- 2. Die cut trees from the 5" x 3 ½" Basic White.
- **3.** Adhere trees to the front of the Designer Series Paper.
- **4.** Stamp snowflakes randomly along the front of the Designer Series Paper using Misty Moonlight ink.
- **5.** Stamp greeting of your choice using Misty Moonlight on the Smoky Slate. Flag the end. Staple the greeting to the front of the Designer Series Paper. Adhere Designer Series Paper to the Basic Gray and then adhere to the card base.
- **6.** Stamp snowflakes using Misty Moonlight for the inside Basic White and for the envelope to match.
- **7.** Add three Clear Ribboned dots to the front of your card.
