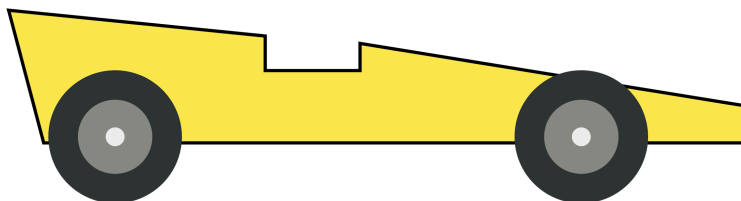
Parking Lot
