Principal's Pen

Our students are doing great work with their studies and demonstrating much responsibility with one another. It is a true pleasure to see them growing both academically and socially.

This past Friday staff and I explored how we can make sure that we can provide quality supervision to students with fewer staff and with less struggle. We revamped our Outdoor Lunch Recess and Grade Level Lunch Plan: Link and our Student Eating Procedure: (Link) Additionally parents may use either gate for drop off and pick up while at the same time we are still encouraging parents to follow our gate plan that better spreads out the children. I believe these changes will yield positive results. Also, parents are asked to help by placing a placard with your child's name on it on your dashboard when you pull up to the loading zone after school. This helps the line move faster and helps staff who may not always recognize you at first glance. Thank you.

Again, volunteers have been helping me with student supervision at lunch. I am so glad we have prioritized volunteer training the past several weeks. Please see the requirements in the article below and the calendar above. I am grateful for community teamwork.

We are expecting rain today. Student lunches will be staggered so that students may eat inside the cafeteria or covered interior hallways. The long range forecast shows no more rain events through November.

Last week we <u>again</u> had no positive Covid tests. We remain steadfast in protecting our school community and are so relieved when we get good reports. Please see the Parent Resource box below for more details on how we are taking extra steps to keep the pandemic from closing down our school and to keep everyone healthy.

Please check your email daily, including each night and each morning before coming to school, to see if a positive COVID-19 case has been identified in your child's class and if your child needs to follow the quarantine protocols. Sometimes we are informed of a positive case late at night, and we need to inform multiple families as quickly as possible that their child needs to be quarantined. If a positive case is identified in your child's class, please know that district nursing staff will follow up with you as part of contact tracing.

DreamBox is a signature program for MES. DreamBox is adaptive and builds conceptual understanding through

games. Students are expected to complete five (5) lessons a week. Dreambox is accessible through Clever on our school website: Link. Students who do so will be recognized regularly at MES. DreamBox also provides data to teachers who can in turn customize assignments for students. Our Teacher Leadership Team and the SSC continue to prioritize DreamBox.
