Fires rage across four Australian states

MELBOURNE, Jan 22 (UPI) – Fire authorities in four Australian states are to control bushfires fanned by strong winds and searing temperatures.

The Australian reported Sunday that blazes continued to burn in South Australia, Tasmania, Western Australia and Victoria, where up to six homes have been destroyed.

In South Australia, much of Adelaide is engulfed in thick smoke. The firefighters who are confronted by blast-furnace winds try to bring the flames under control.

At Robertstown in the state's mid-north, more than 2,500 acres have already burned. Another bushfire, started by lightning, charred the earth near mouth Flat on the southern side of Kangoroo Island, while Ngarkat Conservation Park, in the state's upper-southeast, is also a blaze.

A 7,500-acres fire at mount Agnew inZeehan, in the state's west, broke containment lines Saturday afternoon, jumping a road and coming close to homes.

The most serious fires were in Victoria, where up six homes were destroyed by a fire near the town of Anakie, 36 miles west of Melbourne.

In Tasmania, falling temperatures and patchy rain brought some relief to firefighters, who continued to monitor 22 blazes across the state.

Cigarette smokers are said to have a good chance of getting various fatal disease . but, I think that other's people tobacco smoke seems to increase the chances of non-smokers getting a wide range of cancers.

First, although passive smokers inhale less tobacco smoke, the researchers point out that the smoke you breathe in is richer in many toxic chemicals. There is, for example, three times as much as benzo-apyrene, six times as much toluene and more than 50 times as much dimenthyl nitrosamine. Of course this substance will harm our body in the long run.


Secondly, the recent research reported that the risk of getting cancers not normally associated with smoking also rose among passive smokers. The risk of leukemia raised 6-8 and the risk or cervical cancer increased 3-4 times

Thirdly, past studies have found that by product of cigarette smoke such as coinine and thiocyanate, turn up in the blood, urine and saliva of non smoking adults, children and fetuses have been exposed to smokers. These substances are the main causes various cancers.

In short, the effects of exposure to the cigarette smoking of others are greater than has been previously suspected. That is why passive smokers have more chances of contracting cancer than people with no such exposure.
