From 605 b.c. (first exile) to 536 b.c. (temple rebuild started): 70 years			
From 445 b.c. to the Messiah crucified: 483 (7x7 and 62x7) prophetic years

These visions happened during the second year of Darius's reign (520 b.c.)

Theme: Salvation will come with the temple

I. Call to repentance 1:1-6

II. Eight visions 1:7-6:15 (arranged in Xiatic format)

Man among the myrtle tree and three horses 1:7-17 (the world is at peace)	Four horns and four craftsmen 1:18-21 (Nations of conflicts)	Man with measuring line 2:1-13 (Jerusalem is measured/rebuilt)	Cleansing of High-Priest 3:1-10 (Israel's sin removed)
Four chariots 6:1-8 (Fulfilling God's Heart)	Woman in ephah 5:5-11 (Reflection of Israel's past sins)	Flying scroll 5:1-4 (God's ruling in New Jerusalem)	Gold lampstand and two olive trees 4:1-14 (The Temple and the anointed ones)

 - "You have neglected us. Where is the God of justice?"
 - "I will send my messenger to prepare the way."
 - 2. Dispute #5 3:6-12
 - "You turned your back against me."
 - "How?" "Start offering the tithe."
 - 3. Dispute #6 3:13-18
 - "It is pointless to serve God with inferior offering."
