You are now able to access eBooks and eAudiobooks through the three area public libraries! Your new **AIM card** provides access to all 3 libraries' digital collections by following these few simple steps. These instructions show you how to access the digital collections for all three libraries using the lowa City Public Library website.

1. Go to **icpl.org** and click on "Kids" toward the right side of the blue bar that appears across the top of the screen.



2. After you click on "Kids," scroll down until you see "OverDrive for Kids" under "Digital Library."



3. On the right side of the white bar across the top, click the black "Sign In" button.






4. On the left side of the screen, click the down arrow on the right side of the box where it says "Select your library." Choose "ICCSD Student."




5. Enter the number on your AIM card where it says "Card Number" and click "Sign In."



- 6. There is no password required!
- 7. You can look for books in a number of ways. To look for a specific book or author, use the search tool (magnifying glass) on the top, right of the screen.



8. OR you can use the filters along the left side of the screen to narrow results and browse.
