Github Process for Device Manager repository

- 1. Issue Open initial submittal (needs Read access role)
 - Community clarifies Issue (problem) via comments either individually or via a meeting.
 - Community may provide guidance for the solution in the comments
 - o Community will accept/approve or reject the issue
 - o Issue shall be labeled as 'approved', 'wontfix' or 'duplicate'
 - o Issue may be labeled as 'bug', 'enhancement', 'documentation'
 - One or more 'Assignee's may self-assign (volunteer)
- 2. Assigned Issued (needs Read access role)
 - Assignee(s) forks the repository
 - Assignee makes a pull request and update the issue(s) with PR#
 - When the pull request is complete, the PR shall be labeled 'ready for review'
- 3. Pull Request 'ready to review' (needs Admin role)
 - Reviewers are assigned to verify the PR. Once verified by a review, a comment will be added. Once all the verifications are complete, the PR is labeled "verified" by the reviewers.
 - Community discusses and approves the pull request
 - o TSC arbitrates any disputes
 - Project leadership merges the pull request
