

Github Process for Device Manager repository

1. Issue Open – initial submittal ([needs Read access role](#))
 - Community clarifies Issue (problem) via comments - either individually or via a meeting.
 - Community may provide guidance for the solution in the comments
 - Community will accept/approve or reject the issue
 - Issue shall be labeled as 'approved', 'wontfix' or 'duplicate'
 - Issue may be labeled as 'bug', 'enhancement', 'documentation'
 - One or more 'Assignee's may self-assign (volunteer)
2. Assigned Issued ([needs Read access role](#))
 - Assignee(s) forks the repository
 - Assignee makes a pull request and update the issue(s) with PR#
 - When the pull request is complete, the PR shall be labeled 'ready for review'
3. Pull Request - 'ready to review'([needs Admin role](#))
 - Reviewers are assigned to verify the PR. Once verified by a review, a comment will be added. Once all the verifications are complete, the PR is labeled “verified” by the reviewers.
 - Community discusses and approves the pull request
 - TSC arbitrates any disputes
 - Project leadership merges the pull request
