

Do Re Mi Project Fact Sheet

The Do Re Mi Project (<u>doremiproject.org</u>) is an international 501(c)(3) that connects **elementary and middle school students** with **high school volunteers** for **free online music tutoring**. We've been featured by NPR, Tri-M Music Honor Society, the U.S. Army Band, the Baltimore Sun, and World Journal. Our mission is to **make music education more accessible**.

Since we launched in 2020, we've provided more than 20,000 free online music tutoring sessions and more than \$10,000 in scholarships to kids around the world! Our participants come from 40+ states and 17 countries, and our volunteers go onto conservatories and colleges around the world.

OUR PROGRAMS:

★ Free Online Music Tutoring:

- High school musicians sign up to volunteer on our website.
- o Parents browse and book tutors by instrument on our website.
- The tutoring session happens on an outside video app, like Zoom.
- Lessons are completely free and can be booked unlimited times!

★ Accelerando Scholarship:

Our <u>annual scholarship competition</u> provides thousands in scholarships to Do Re
Mi's tutors and students. Tutors and students film short videos and write short
responses about their experiences with music and Do Re Mi.

★ International Music Competition:

 Our <u>annual music competition</u> provides thousands in prizes to Do Re Mi's tutors and students, along with constructive feedback from professional judges. Tutors and students submit videos of themselves performing on their instruments.

★ Free Online Masterclasses and Panels:

 Do Re Mi hosts free online masterclasses for our members to play for and receive feedback from guests like concertmasters and principal players of the Philadelphia Orchestra, Chicago Symphony, the Baltimore Symphony, and other leading



orchestras, **Broadway singers**, and **faculty** at leading conservatories and festivals like **Curtis Institute of Music**, **Northwestern**, **NEC**, and **Heifetz**.

Geared towards tutors, our panels have included guests like Daniel Thrasher (5 mil+subscribers on YouTube), admissions officers at conservatories like Eastman
 Conservatory of Music, and professional music teachers that have led their ensembles to the Midwest Clinic!

★ In-Person Community Outreach Program:

 Do Re Mi's <u>Community Outreach Coordinators</u> organize in-person concerts at nursing homes, schools, and hospitals across the country. This serves as an opportunity for high school students to gain organization experience and for our members to gain performance experience while giving back to their communities!

★ Online Student Recitals:

- Do Re Mi regularly hosts online recitals for our students and tutors to perform in! This
 is a great opportunity to celebrate and share all the hard work our students and
 tutors put into their instruments, and for students to gain performance experience!
