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 This manual covers every feature of the QR Pro Scanner in plain language. No formulas, no code — just what you need to know to trade effectively with the scanner every session.

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1. Getting Started

Accessing the Scanner

The QR Pro Scanner is a cloud-based trading dashboard that runs entirely in your web browser — no software to install, no downloads required. It is live and ready every trading day.

The scanner works best on a desktop or laptop computer in Google Chrome or Microsoft Edge. Keep your browser window open during the trading session — the scanner connects automatically and updates in real time as signals fire.

Login Methods

The scanner offers three ways to log in:

Access Code Login

When you purchased scanner access you received a unique access code in your welcome email. Enter this code on the login screen (format: QR-XXXX-XXXX) to gain access.

💡 Bookmark the scanner URL and keep your access code saved somewhere handy. If you ever lose your code, reply to your original purchase confirmation email and it will be resent.

Patreon Login

Members of the **Rockbot Scripts NT8 & TradingView** Patreon tier get instant access by clicking the 🎨 **LOGIN WITH PATREON** button on the login screen. Your Patreon account is verified automatically.

DTR Member Login

Active **daytradingradio.com** members get the QR Pro Scanner free. Click the 🟢 **I'M A DTR MEMBER** button and enter your membership email address. Your membership is verified automatically and an access code is sent to your email within 1 minute.

📄 DTR member access is verified daily. As long as your membership remains active, your access code continues to work automatically.

First Time Setup

- Click the 🔊 ON button in the top right to enable audio alerts

- Allow audio when prompted by your browser — without this step, spoken alerts will not play
- Set your volume using the slider next to the ON/OFF button
- Use the – % + buttons in the bottom right corner to zoom in or out until the layout fits your screen
- Click 🌙 DARK for a dark theme — your setting is saved automatically across sessions

2. Scanner Layout Overview

The scanner is organized into several key areas. Here is what each area does:

Area	What It Does
Header Bar	Shows scanner status, connection indicator, audio controls, zoom, dark mode toggle, and current Eastern time.
Timed Alerts	Full-width flash banners that automatically appear at key market times (9:28 AM, 9:48 AM, 3:48 PM ET) with voice announcements.
Copy Trading Cards	Live account P&L dashboard showing DayTraderRockStar's trading accounts in real time (Copy Trading tier members).
Instrument Cards	Five cards showing the current signal status for ES, NQ, GC, BTC, and YM across all three timeframes with stochastic bars.
Middle Row	Three panels side by side: Key Levels (support/resistance), Pre-Market Scanner, and Trade Notes/Blog.
VortexFlow™ Gauge	Momentum regime indicator in the right sidebar. Shows overall market direction and strength.
Extreme Flag ID™	Proprietary gauge that detects Extreme Bull and Bear Flag setups on ES in real time.
Live Charts	Real-time ES and NQ candlestick charts with stochastic panes, signal markers, and level lines.
Signal Matrix	Full grid showing the active signal for every instrument across every timeframe at a glance.
Right Sidebar	Live alert feed, My Trades tracker. Scrolling log of all session signals.
Fear & Greed Index	CNN Fear & Greed Index displayed live within the scanner interface.
Stock of the Week	Current SOTW setup posted by DayTraderRockStar, updated each week.
Live Polls	Interactive member polls that pop up during the session with live vote results.

Area	What It Does
Floating DTR Live	Minimizable YouTube live stream widget so you can watch DTR radio while using the scanner.

3. Instruments & Timeframes

The QR Pro Scanner monitors five futures instruments simultaneously across three timeframes. You never need to switch charts or watch multiple screens — the scanner watches everything at once.

Instruments

- **ES** — S&P 500 E-mini Futures
- **NQ** — NASDAQ 100 E-mini Futures
- **GC** — Gold Futures
- **BTC** — Bitcoin Futures
- **YM** — Dow Jones E-mini Futures

Timeframes

- **1 Minute** — Short-term, fast signals for scalping
- **3 Minute** — Intermediate, the core trading timeframe
- **5 Minute** — Longer-term confirmation

 Each instrument is scanned on all three timeframes independently. When signals align across multiple timeframes on the same instrument, it is a stronger indication of a genuine move.

4. Signal Types Explained

The scanner uses a multi-stage system to identify high-probability trade setups. The table below summarizes every signal the scanner can produce:

Signal	What It Means
 ARMED LONG	First stage alert. Stochastic conditions are aligning for a potential long trade. The system is watching closely — not yet confirmed.
 ARMED SHORT	First stage alert. Stochastic conditions are aligning for a potential short trade.
 BUY	Full bullish signal confirmed. High-probability long setup detected on this instrument and timeframe.
 SELL	Full bearish signal confirmed. High-probability short setup detected on this instrument and timeframe.
 DIV BULL	Divergence detected — price and momentum moving in opposite directions with bullish implications. Early warning of a potential reversal to the upside.
 DIV BEAR	Divergence detected — price and momentum moving in opposite directions with bearish implications. Early warning of a potential reversal to the downside.
 NQ 22R DIV BULL	Higher timeframe divergence on the NQ 22-Range chart signaling bullish reversal potential. More significant when aligned with regular timeframe signals.
 NQ 22R DIV BEAR	Higher timeframe divergence on the NQ 22-Range chart signaling bearish reversal potential.
 40-4 DIV BULL	Second-stage divergence confirmation. Momentum has confirmed the divergence setup at a deeper level — higher conviction than a standard DIV.
 40-4 DIV BEAR	Second-stage divergence confirmation — bearish. Higher conviction divergence signal.
 REVERSAL BULL	A reversal candle (engulfing or outside bar) has formed in the direction of active divergence — direct price action confirmation. Stop price is automatically calculated and displayed.

Signal	What It Means
 REVERSAL BEAR	A reversal candle has formed in the direction of active bearish divergence. Stop price is automatically calculated.
 PERFECT BULL	HIGHEST CONVICTION signal. The divergence extreme itself was the reversal candle — price reversed exactly at the divergence low. Stop is 5 ticks from the divergence extreme.
 PERFECT BEAR	HIGHEST CONVICTION signal. The divergence extreme itself was the reversal candle — price reversed exactly at the divergence high.
 DUAL TF BUY	A BUY signal has fired on the same instrument on two different timeframes within a short window. Strong confirmation of the setup.
 DUAL TF SELL	A SELL signal has fired on the same instrument on two different timeframes. Strong confirmation of the short setup.
 DUAL TF DIV BULL	Divergence signals confirmed on two different timeframes on the same instrument simultaneously — bullish. Signal incoming warning.
 DUAL TF DIV BEAR	Divergence signals confirmed on two different timeframes on the same instrument simultaneously — bearish.
 9-3 COIL BULL	Coil setup complete. The fast stochastic has made a specific series of movements that historically precede a strong bullish directional move — like a compressed spring about to release.
 9-3 COIL BEAR	Coil setup complete — bearish. Spring compressed to the downside.
 20-20 EXTREME BULL FLAG	The Extreme Flag Identifier has detected that the 9-3 stochastic is at lows AND the 60-10 stochastic is at highs, with price above the 20 EMA. Highest quality bull flag condition.
 20-20 EXTREME BEAR FLAG	Extreme Flag Identifier detects 9-3 at highs AND 60-10 at lows with price below the 20 EMA. Highest quality bear flag condition.

 A BUY or SELL signal is not a guarantee. Always manage your risk with a defined stop loss. Use the stop price shown on the signal popup when available.

5. Instrument Cards

The five instrument cards across the top of the scanner show you the current state of each market at a glance. Each card displays:

- Instrument symbol and name
- Current signal status badge with color coding
- Most recent signal with timestamp and price
- Stochastic readings for 1m, 3m, and 5m timeframes as color-coded bars
- Session high and low prices, updated live throughout the trading day

Stochastic Bars

Each instrument card shows three small colored bars representing the 1m, 3m, and 5m stochastic readings:

- **Green** — Stochastic is in bullish territory (below 20, oversold zone)
- **Red** — Stochastic is in bearish territory (above 80, overbought zone)
- **Blue** — Stochastic is in the neutral middle zone



When all three bars are the same color, all timeframes are aligned — this is a higher probability setup condition worth watching closely.

6. VortexFlow™ Momentum Gauge

 The VortexFlow™ gauge is located in the right sidebar and provides a continuous real-time read on overall market momentum regime.

VortexFlow™ reads multiple market inputs and gives you a single score from 0 to 100 that tells you whether the market is in a bullish, bearish, or neutral regime right now.

Symbol Selector

Use the four buttons at the top of the gauge to select the instrument you want to monitor: NQ, ES, SPY, or QQQ. The gauge updates automatically when you switch symbols.

Regime Labels

Score	Regime Label
80 – 100	▲ LOAD UP — Strong bullish conditions. Momentum strongly favors longs.
60 – 79	↗ LEAN BUY — Moderate bullish lean. Conditions favor buyers.
40 – 59	↔ WAIT — Neutral. No clear directional bias — stand aside.
20 – 39	↘ LEAN SELL — Moderate bearish lean. Conditions favor sellers.
0 – 19	▼ DUMP IT — Strong bearish conditions. Momentum strongly favors shorts.

How to Use VortexFlow™

Use the VortexFlow™ gauge as a market regime filter. When it shows LOAD UP or LEAN BUY, conditions favor looking for BUY signals from the main scanner. When it shows DUMP IT or LEAN SELL, conditions favor looking for SELL signals. Avoid forcing trades in the WAIT zone.

 VortexFlow™ status: LIVE (green dot) means the data is current. STALE (yellow) means data is more than 5 minutes old. OFFLINE (red) means the feed is not available.

7. Extreme Flag Identifier™

NEW The Extreme Flag Identifier™ (EXTREME FLAG ID™) is an exclusive ES scalping gauge located in the right sidebar, below the VortexFlow™ gauge. It detects high-quality flag compression setups on the 1-minute ES chart.

This gauge reads two proprietary stochastic measurements simultaneously — the fast 9-3 stochastic and the longer-term 60-10 stochastic — along with the 20 EMA and 200 EMA positions. When these align in a specific configuration, the gauge lights up with a flag setup.

The Gauge Needle

The main visual is a semicircular needle gauge:

- **Needle pointing RIGHT (green zone)** — Long/bull flag conditions are present
- **Needle pointing LEFT (red zone)** — Short/bear flag conditions are present
- **Needle in the CENTER** — No flag setup — neutral conditions

Setup Labels

Label	What It Means
 20-20 EXTREME BULL FLAG	Highest quality setup: 9-3 stochastic at or below 25 AND 60-10 stochastic at or above 75 AND price above the 20 EMA. All conditions perfectly aligned for a bullish flag.
 20-20 EXTREME BEAR FLAG	Highest quality setup — bearish: 9-3 at or above 75 AND 60-10 at or below 25 AND price below 20 EMA.
POSSIBLE BULL FLAG 	Strong bull flag conditions: 60-10 embedded above 80 for 3+ consecutive bars AND 9-3 in the low zone. Price is also above the 200 EMA (full quality).
POSSIBLE BULL FLAG 	Bull flag conditions present but price is below the 200 EMA — reduced conviction.
POSSIBLE BEAR FLAG 	Strong bear flag conditions: 60-10 embedded below 20 for 3+ consecutive bars AND 9-3 in the high zone. Price below 200 EMA.
POSSIBLE BEAR FLAG 	Bear flag conditions present but price is above the 200 EMA — reduced conviction.
WATCHING BULL / WATCHING BEAR	Conditions are developing but not fully aligned yet. Stay alert.
NO FLAG	No flag setup present. Stand aside.

Data Panels

Below the gauge needle, four small panels show the underlying readings:

- **60-10 EMBED** — How many consecutive bars the 60-10 stochastic has been in an extreme zone (above 80 or below 20). Needs to reach 3+ for a full setup.
- **60-10** — Current value of the 60-10 stochastic. Red when above 80 (overbought), green when below 20 (oversold).
- **EMA 20** — Whether current ES price is ABOVE or BELOW the 20-period EMA. Green = above (bullish). Red = below (bearish).
- **200 EMA** — Whether current ES price is ABOVE or BELOW the 200-period EMA. Above = trend favors longs. Below = trend favors shorts.

💡 The 20-20 Extreme Flag is the highest quality setup: the fast stochastic has pulled back (compressed) while the big-picture momentum is still embedded in an extreme, AND price is on the right side of the 20 EMA. When this fires, the scanner voices an alert automatically.

Voice Alerts

The Extreme Flag Identifier fires voice alerts automatically when a new setup type is detected. The alert includes the setup type, direction, and EMA position. A 30-second cooldown prevents repeated alerts on the same setup.

8. Copy Trading Cards



Copy Trading is available to members on the Copy Trading Patreon tier. This feature shows DayTraderRockStar's live trading accounts in real time.

When the Copy Trading panel is active, you will see cards at the top of the scanner showing:

- Total account balance across all tracked accounts
- Daily P&L (profit and loss for the current session)
- Open P&L (unrealized gains/losses on open positions)
- Individual account cards for each tracked account with their own balance and P&L
- Connected member count — how many Copy Trade members are currently connected
- Copy Trading Active indicator — green when trades are being executed

Copy Trade Alerts

When a new trade is executed in the copy trading accounts, a voice alert fires automatically. A female voice announces the instrument, direction (Bought/Sold), quantity, and price. The Copy Trade alert feed below the cards shows a running log of recent trades.

Muting Copy Trade Alerts

Use the  **MUTE** /  **UNMUTE** button on the Copy Trading panel to toggle copy trade voice alerts independently from main scanner signals.

My Trades Feed

The My Trades panel in the right sidebar shows DayTraderRockStar's recent transactions pulled live from the portfolio tracker. Each entry shows the symbol, whether it was a buy or sell, quantity, price, and realized P&L where available.

9. Key Levels Panel

The Key Levels panel shows important price levels for each tracked instrument. These are the levels the market is most likely to react to during the session.

What Levels Are Shown

- **Previous Day High (PH)** — Red line on chart

- **Previous Day Low (PL)** — Green line on chart
- **Previous Day Close (PC)** — White line on chart
- **Previous Day Open (PO)** — Orange line on chart
- **Daily Pivot Point** — Yellow line on chart
- **Fibonacci Levels** — Key percentage retracements between PH and PL
- **Today's Session High / Low** — Updates live throughout the session

NEAR Badge & Audio Alerts

When price approaches one of these key levels, the panel highlights the level with a NEAR badge and the scanner fires an audio alert to give you advance warning before price reaches the level.

 Each level alert has a 5-minute cooldown after it fires to prevent it from repeating every tick when price is hovering near the level.

10. Pre-Market Scanner

The Pre-Market Scanner panel shows two types of data refreshed every 30–60 seconds:

- **Gap Scanner** — Stocks with significant pre-market gaps from the previous close. Both gap-up and gap-down movers are listed. Pre-market gappers are likely to see elevated volume and volatility at the open.
- **Pre-Market Movers** — Broader list of stocks showing significant pre-market activity, with percent change from prior close.

Use this panel at the start of each session to identify which stocks are likely to be in play when the market opens.

11. Trade Notes & Admin Blog

The Trade Notes panel shows real-time notes from DayTraderRockStar during the live session. This is used to post key levels, market commentary, trade setups to watch, and general game-plan information.

Notes may include images and video links. A

NEW banner appears at the top of the scanner when DayTraderRockStar has posted a new note, and a popup notification may appear. Click anywhere on the note popup to dismiss it.

 Check the Trade Notes panel at the start of each session for the game plan. Notes update instantly when posted — no refresh needed.

12. Live Charts

Below the middle panels, the scanner shows two live candlestick charts side by side — ES on the left and NQ on the right. These charts update in real time as each new candle forms.

Chart Features

- Live candlestick chart — green candles for bullish bars, red for bearish
- Previous day H/L/O/C lines plotted directly on the chart as colored dashed lines
- Daily pivot line in yellow
- Signal markers — arrows and symbols appear directly on the candle where each signal fired

Signal Markers on Chart

Marker	Signal Type
▲ Green Arrow (below bar)	BUY signal
▼ Red Arrow (above bar)	SELL signal
⚡ Yellow (below/above bar)	ARMED signal
◆ Purple marker	Divergence signal (DIV BULL or DIV BEAR)
⌚ Purple marker	Reversal candle signal
★ Gold circle (large)	Perfect Setup — highest conviction

Nexus Trader Signal Markers

If you run the SuperTrader (Nexus) strategy in NinjaTrader, its signals plot directly on your live charts in real time, alongside the Scanner's own markers on the same candles. A legend strip above the chart area shows all seven signal types at a glance.

Marker	Direction & Color
TL — Trendline Touch	Long: teal ▲ below bar. Short: teal ▼ above bar.

Marker	Direction & Color
QD — Quad Divergence	Long: cyan ▲ below bar. Short: cyan ▼ above bar.
FLG — Bull/Bear Flag	Long: blue ▲ below bar. Short: blue ▼ above bar.
E20 — 20 EMA Reversal	Long: indigo ▲ below bar. Short: indigo ▼ above bar.
ALN — Trendline Full Align	Long: violet ▲ below bar. Short: violet ▼ above bar.
PD — Price/Stoch Divergence	Long: pink ▲ below bar. Short: pink ▼ above bar.
QRD — Quad Rotation Divergence	Long: amber ▲ below bar. Short: amber ▼ above bar.

i Nexus markers show whenever SuperTrader's entry condition is true — live or flat, whether or not a trade is actually taken. It's a real-time read on what the strategy is seeing, not a trade log.

Timeframe Selector

Use the 1m / 3m / 5m buttons at the top of the chart panel to switch between timeframes. Both ES and NQ charts switch together.

Expand / Collapse

Click the EXPAND button to maximize the charts to near full-screen height. Click COLLAPSE to return to the compact view.

Stochastic Pane

Below each candlestick chart is a stochastic indicator pane showing the 9-3 fast stochastic %D line in cyan. Two yellow horizontal lines mark the 80 (overbought) and 20 (oversold) zones. The timescale on both charts stays synchronized so they scroll together.

13. HYPERSCALER™ Entry Gauge & Trade Tracker

 This section covers the full HYPERSCALER™ gauge — which is the same tool as the Extreme Flag Identifier described in Section 7 but with the trade tracker component explained in detail.

The HYPERSCALER™ is the real-time entry quality gauge built specifically for 1-minute ES scalping. It lives in the right sidebar and provides both a setup quality gauge and a live trade tracker in the same widget.

Setup Quality

Refer to Section 7 (Extreme Flag Identifier™) for a full description of the gauge needle, setup labels, and data panels. The quality score (Q) shown on the 20-20 Extreme Flag is 100 — maximum quality.

Trade Tracker

When the gauge detects a LONG SETUP or SHORT SETUP, the Trade Tracker activates automatically:

- The entry price is displayed at the start
- Green bars stack upward on a long trade as each new candle makes a higher high
- Red bars stack downward on a short trade as each new candle makes a lower low
- The tracker monitors the fast stochastic in real time for exhaustion

Trade Complete Signal

When the stochastic reaches an extreme level on the opposite side — indicating the momentum move is exhausted — the tracker shows TRADE COMPLETE and fires a cash register audio alert.

 The cash register sound means the trade has reached its momentum target. Protect your gains. Do not let a winning trade turn into a loser by holding past this signal.

Auto-Reset

The Trade Tracker resets automatically when the next setup fires on the gauge. Each new signal starts fresh with a new entry price and new tracking bars.

14. Signal Matrix

The Signal Matrix is a complete grid showing every instrument across every timeframe in one view — 15 cells total (5 instruments × 3 timeframes). Each cell shows the current signal with its color coding:

- **Green** — Bullish signal (BUY, ARMED LONG, DIV BULL, REVERSAL BULL, PERFECT BULL, COIL BULL)
- **Red** — Bearish signal (SELL, ARMED SHORT, DIV BEAR, REVERSAL BEAR, PERFECT BEAR, COIL BEAR)
- **Yellow** — Armed or watching state
- **Purple** — Divergence signal
- **Gray** — Waiting / no signal

Use the matrix to quickly scan all 15 combinations at once. When multiple cells are lighting up in the same direction across instruments and timeframes, it indicates broad market momentum — higher conviction conditions.

Hottest Right Now

Above the Signal Matrix, this panel automatically ranks all 15 symbol/timeframe cells by how close each one is to firing — so you don't have to scan the whole grid yourself.

- **Top 4, numbered 1-4, left to right** — #1 (far left) is the single closest thing to setting up right now.
- **Heat bar** — the fuller the bar, the closer to (or the stronger) that signal is. A cell still “Watching” but drifting toward an extreme climbs this list before it officially arms.
- **Ranking order** — fired signals always outrank “Watching” cells, and rank further by strength (a PERFECT setup outranks a plain DIV, which outranks ARMED).



Check this panel first when you sit down at the Scanner — it's the fastest way to see where the action is without scanning the full matrix yourself.

Momentum Arrows & Confluence Brackets

Two indicators built directly into the Signal Matrix cells, using data the Scanner already tracks:

- **Momentum arrows (▲ ▼)** — next to each timeframe label, comparing the two most recent 9-3 stochastic readings. ▲ means it's turning up, ▼ means it's turning down — useful for catching a shift before the cell's main signal changes.
- **Confluence brackets** — when 2 or more timeframes on the same symbol show the same signal type at once (the same rule that powers DUAL BUY/DUAL SELL), those

cells get a colored top border, a soft glow, and a small “⚡ w/ [timeframe]” tag naming which other timeframe agrees.

Multiple timeframes lighting up together with a visible bracket is a stronger read than any single cell alone — genuine agreement across your setup, not just one noisy reading.

15. Timed Market Announcements

The scanner automatically fires specific announcements at key times during the trading day in Eastern Time. These appear as full-width banner alerts at the top of the scanner and are announced by voice:

Time (ET)	Announcement
9:28 AM	 Market Opens in 2 Minutes — prepare your setups
9:48 AM	 Entering the 9:50 Reversal Zone — watch for reversals around 9:50 AM ET
3:48 PM	 Warning — Murder Algo in 2 Minutes — the 3:50 PM algorithmic move is about to begin

 These announcements fire automatically — no action required. They help you stay aware of the most important intraday time windows without watching the clock.

16. Fear & Greed Index

The scanner pulls the CNN Fear & Greed Index in real time and displays it in the interface. The index measures overall market sentiment on a scale from 0 (Extreme Fear) to 100 (Extreme Greed):

- **0 – 20:** Extreme Fear — market participants are very fearful; historically a buying opportunity
- **21 – 40:** Fear
- **41 – 60:** Neutral
- **61 – 80:** Greed
- **81 – 100:** Extreme Greed — participants are very greedy; historically a caution signal

The display also shows the previous close, 1-week-ago, and 1-month-ago readings for context. The index updates every 5 minutes.

17. Stock of the Week

The Stock of the Week (SOTW) panel displays the current weekly stock setup posted by DayTraderRockStar. It includes the ticker symbol, setup description, entry zone, and target levels. This updates each week and refreshes in the scanner every minute.

18. Live Member Polls

Occasionally during the session a poll popup will appear on your scanner. Simply click your answer to vote, and you will see the live results from all members instantly. Polls close automatically after a short time. You can dismiss the poll card by clicking outside it.

19. Audio Alerts

The scanner speaks every signal out loud so you never have to stare at the screen. When a signal fires, you will hear it announced with the instrument name, timeframe, and signal type.

Audio Controls

-  **ON /  OFF button** — Master toggle for all scanner audio
- **Volume slider** — Adjust the alert volume next to the ON/OFF button
-  **AUDIO button** — Opens the full Audio Panel where you can enable or disable individual signal types and mute specific instruments

Audio Panel — Individual Signal Controls

Inside the Audio Panel you can toggle audio on or off for each signal type independently. For example, you can disable ARMED alerts while keeping BUY/SELL audio on. You can also mute specific instruments — if you are not trading NQ, mute it so only ES, GC, BTC, and YM alerts play.

Live Voice Alerts from DayTraderRockStar

During live trading sessions, DayTraderRockStar can broadcast live voice alerts directly through your scanner. When this happens, you will hear the announcement playing through your speakers automatically — no action required on your part. A banner appears while the alert is active. These alerts are logged in the Audio Alert History for the session.

Signal-Specific Audio Announcements

Signal	Audio Behavior
ARMED LONG / SHORT	Announces: "[Symbol], [Timeframe], Quad Rotation System Armed for Buy/Sell"
BUY / SELL	Full announcement with symbol, timeframe, and direction. Fires a buy or sell chime tone in addition to voice.
DIV BULL / BEAR	Announces: "[Symbol], [Timeframe], 40-4 Divergence Bull/Bear confirmed"
40-4 DIV (Stage 2)	Announces: "[Symbol], [Timeframe], 40-4 Divergence Bull/Bear — Stage 2 confirmed"

Signal	Audio Behavior
NQ 22R DIV	Announces: "NQ, 22 Range, Simple Divergence Bull/Bear"
9-3 COIL	Announces: "[Symbol], [Timeframe], 9-3 Coil Bull/Bear complete. Coiled spring ready to buy/sell"
DUAL TF BUY/SELL	Urgent announcement: "[Symbol]! Dual Timeframe Quad Divergence! Extreme Buy/Sell Signal! Both timeframes confirmed!"
DUAL TF DIV	Urgent announcement: "[Symbol]! Dual Timeframe Divergence Confirmed! Both timeframes showing Bull/Bear Divergence. Signal incoming!"
REVERSAL BULL/BEAR	Announces candle type, direction, and stop price automatically.
PERFECT SETUP	Loudest and most detailed alert: "Attention! [Symbol], [Timeframe], Perfect Setup! Direction with reversal candle at the divergence extreme! Stop at [price]. This is a high conviction trade!"
Extreme Flag Alert	Voice fires when a new Extreme Flag setup type is detected. 30-second cooldown between alerts.
Trade Complete	Cash register chime fires when the Trade Tracker detects momentum exhaustion.
Key Level NEAR	Voice announces which level price is approaching.
Economic News Countdown	Warns at 10 minutes, 5 minutes, and 2 minutes before scheduled news events.

20. Economic News Calendar

The scanner monitors upcoming economic news events and fires advance audio warnings at 10 minutes, 5 minutes, and 2 minutes before each event. This ensures you are never caught off guard by a scheduled news release during the trading session.

The news event name is announced by voice each time. These alerts fire automatically — no setup required.

21. Alert Feed

The Alert Feed in the right sidebar is a real-time log of every signal that has fired during the session. Each entry shows the instrument, timeframe, signal type, price, stochastic readings, and how long ago it fired.

Scroll through the feed to review what has happened during the session. Older signals are shown in a lighter style. The feed holds up to 200 alerts per session.

Signal Popup Cards

When certain signals fire (BUY, SELL, divergence, reversal, and Perfect Setup), a popup card appears briefly in the center of the scanner with a summary of the signal including direction, recommendation, stop price, and candle type. Perfect Setup cards stay on screen for 30 seconds. Standard signal cards auto-dismiss after 20–25 seconds.

22. Floating DTR Live Stream Widget

A floating YouTube live stream widget appears in the bottom-right corner of the scanner while DTR Live is broadcasting. This lets you watch DayTraderRockStar's live stream directly inside the scanner without switching tabs.

Controls

- **▼ MIN** — Minimizes the video player to just the header bar. Click **► EXPAND** to restore.
- **×** — Hides the widget completely. A small DTR LIVE indicator remains in the corner. Click it to restore the widget.
- **Open Full ↗** — Opens the full YouTube live stream in a new tab.

23. Display Controls

Zoom

Use the **– % +** controls fixed in the bottom right corner to zoom the entire scanner in or out until it fits your display perfectly. Your zoom setting (0.5× to 1.5×) is saved automatically across sessions.

Dark Mode

Click the  **DARK** button in the header to switch to a dark background theme. Click  **LIGHT** to return to the standard theme. Your preference is saved automatically.

PAUSE / ► PLAY

The PAUSE button freezes the alert feed so you can review recent signals without new ones pushing them off screen. Hit PLAY to resume the live feed. Audio alerts continue to fire even when the feed is paused.

24. Tips for Getting the Most From the Scanner

 **Best Practice:** Let the scanner do the watching. Keep it open on a second monitor or dedicated screen during your trading session. Audio alerts mean you can focus on your trading platform — the scanner notifies you when something is happening.

- Start each session by checking the Trade Notes panel for the game plan and key levels
- Check the VortexFlow™ gauge to understand the current market regime before looking at individual signals
- Watch for signals that align across multiple timeframes on the same instrument — higher conviction
- Watch for signals that align across multiple instruments at the same time — broad market momentum
- Use the Key Levels panel to know where important price levels are before price gets there
- ARMED signals give you advance warning — start paying attention when you see one
- A Perfect Setup 🎯 is the highest conviction alert — when you hear it, be ready with your platform
- The Extreme Flag Identifier™ 20-20 setup is the top-quality scalp condition — use it to time entries
- Dual Timeframe signals are significantly stronger than single-timeframe signals — treat them as priority
- The cash register sound from the Trade Tracker means the scalp has run its course — protect profits
- Check the Fear & Greed Index for overall market sentiment context
- Use the floating DTR Live widget to follow along with DayTraderRockStar's commentary while trading
- If the scanner shows OFFLINE or disconnected, refresh the page — it reconnects automatically
- Adjust the volume slider if alerts are too loud or too quiet for your setup
- The stochastic bars on the instrument cards give you a quick overview of market positioning at a glance
