SILLVR streaming video pilot program - Katy from Auraria

- Infobase films available to all Prospector libraries at no cost

Prospector Fulfillment Stats

Clarified ratio of lends to borrows and that several factors, including collection uniqueness and emedia vs. physical holdings can contribute to having a higher ratio of lends to borrows or vice versa.

• Discussed <u>INN-Reach Title Reports</u> and applications such as multiple requests for same title as prompt purchase local copy, etc.

Gold Rush Content Comparison Tool - Rose

Can be used to compare your holdings to other libraries, find what is unique or widely owned. Can inform weeding decisions.

Can also look at your own collection and see visual depictions of your holdings.

Right now, all Alliance Members have their holdings in Gold Rush as well as DPL. Other Prospector libraries can add theirs as well.
