- Not smoke or use vapes within the club compound or buildings
- Not sail whilst under the influence of alcohol or drugs that may impair your ability to function in a safe and informed way
- Not use illegal substances whilst on club premises

- An environment which is free from discrimination, harassment and victimisation
- Safe spaces and opportunities where you can report any concerns and know they will be investigated in accordance with Sailability@Whitefriars policies, procedures and rules

- To enjoy your sailing and boating however you wish to undertake it within the limits of Sailability@Whitefriars
