Instructions for Priests, Deacons and Seminarians attending a Chant Intensive Course

Dear Fathers, Deacons and seminarians,

Welcome to Chant Intensive. We are so happy to have you with us!

Here are some practical points for your preparations.

- 1. We don't have the staff to be able to arrange for private Masses. You may be able to concelebrate Tuesday and Wednesday at Duquesne University's Chapel of the Holy Spirit. You will need to contact the chapel to arrange that yourself. On Friday noon, you may wish to concelebrate during the closing Mass for the course at the Duquesne University Chapel. If you do not wish to concelebrate, you may bring a Mass kit with you to say Mass privately in your room.
- 2. Each Priest and Deacon will need to bring with him a new "letter of suitability" from his Diocese or Religious Order. The document must have the raised seal of your Diocese or Religious Order on it. A copy will be needed for the Duquesne Chapel Office. 3. To concelebrate during the Mass on Friday noon at the Duquesne University Chapel, you will need an alb and "WHITE" stole and vestment.

4. If you are a seminarian and would like to serve for Mass on Friday, bring your cassock and surplice. If you do not serve Mass, you are invited to attend Mass in choir dress; cassock, surplice and biretta (optional).
