To qualify for this scholarship, the applicant must write an essay about someone they know (or themselves) who has had to be persistent in some phase of their life. It may be physical (as it was for Dan), academic, emotional, economic or spiritual. The minimum length of the essay is 250 words (one page, double spaced, typed). This scholarship is worth approximately \$100.

In addition to relating an example of persistence as described above, please describe the effect of how understanding persistence; in the face of adversity (any type of struggle or suffering), is important in the individual's life. This can be shown by discussing how this can strengthen your relationship with God or contribute to your success in attaining your goals, or both as was the case of Dan Holoubek's life. As part of your essay, please include your area of study you plan to go into in college (college major).
